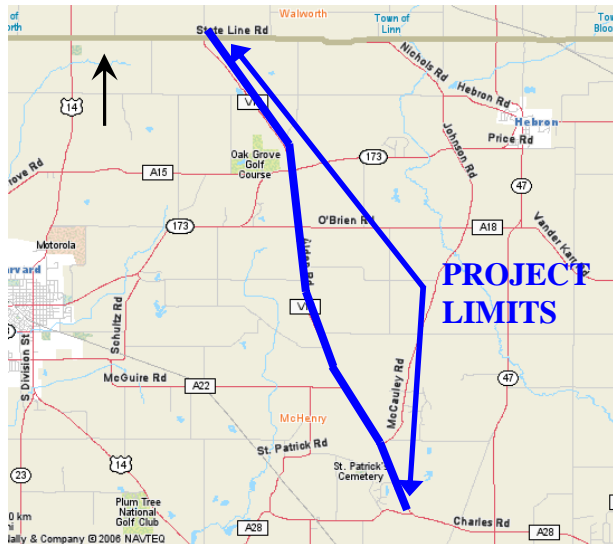

## **Alden Road Public Hearing**

The Public Hearing is being held to present the revised design of the proposed improvement of Alden Road between Nelson Road and State Line Road and to gather public comment regarding the project.

### **What will this improvement do?**

- Reconstruct the deteriorated pavement.
- Regrade drainage ditches and install new cross road culverts to improve stormwater drainage along the road.
- Widen shoulders and reconfiguring intersections as safety enhancements.

### **What are the proposed improvements?**

The improvements consist of replacing the existing two-lane Alden Road pavement with a proposed two-lane pavement. The drainage ditches will be regraded and cross road culverts will be replaced to improve roadway drainage.

### **Cost**

\$20 to \$25 million (varies depending on extent of rehabilitation of pavement versus complete reconstruction).

## **Project Schedule**

- The earliest that construction would begin is 3 to 5 years from 2011. The project will likely be constructed in segments.
- This project is not currently in the McHenry County 5-year improvement plan.
- Funding has not been identified by the County Board for the Alden Road improvements.

### **Additional Right-of-Way and Easements**

In order to construct the improvements, additional property (right-of-way) will be required in some areas. Permanent and temporary construction easements will also be required in different areas for grading, drainage improvements and driveway adjustments. The areas of additional right-of-way and additional easements are identified on the Public Hearing exhibits and can also be viewed at the McHenry County Division of Transportation office after this Public Hearing.

### **Meeting Agenda**

The Public Hearing is your opportunity to discuss the project in detail with McHenry County Division of Transportation (MCDOT) representatives and consultant staff. A brief PowerPoint presentation regarding the proposed improvements will be shown several times during the evening. Following the viewing of the presentation, you will have an opportunity to provide your comments through an open house style meeting. MCDOT representatives and consultant staff will be available to answer individual questions regarding the project and its impact on individual properties. The exhibits can be viewed either during this time or Thursday, January 27<sup>th</sup> at the MCDOT office from 9 am to 12 pm. Please view the exhibits, and feel free to ask any questions. It is important that you provide your comments. Written comment forms are available, or you may give verbal comments to the court reporter.
