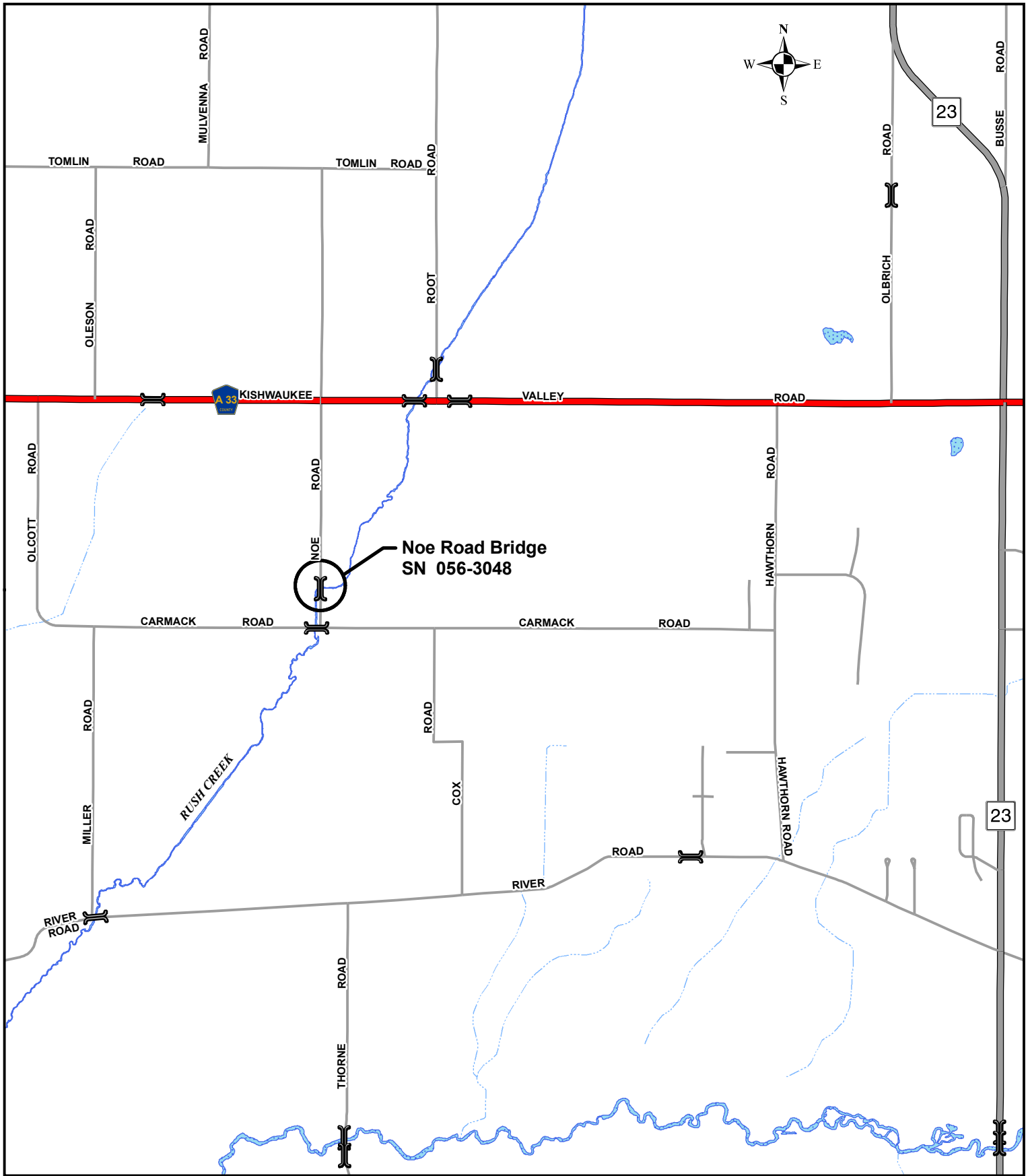
Noe Road Bridge Closed Beginning March 13, 2009

The McHenry County Division of Transportation, in conjunction with the Marengo Township Road District, will close the Noe Road Bridge over Rush Creek in unincorporated Marengo Township. The closure is due to a loss of structural integrity of the bridge deck beams. Local residents are advised to find an alternate route

The McHenry County Division of Transportation and the Marengo Township Road District are currently considering possible options and alternatives for replacement of the bridge. The duration of the closure is indefinite; however, the bridge has been programmed for replacement with the McHenry County Division of Transportation's Five Year Highway Improvement Program.

Inspections are accomplished on a routine basis and intermittently as required on all bridges on Township roads and County Highways throughout McHenry County, as a coordinated effort between the McHenry County Division of Transportation and the local Township Road Districts. These inspections are performed as required by the Illinois Department of Transportation.

The Noe Road Bridge is located northwest of Marengo and southwest of Harvard. The Noe Road Bridge crosses a small waterway known as Rush Creek, a branch of the Kishwaukee River. Its southern terminus is at Carmack Road and its northern terminus is at Kishwaukee Valley Road in McHenry County. See attached location map.
