Pets can be identified and redeemed at McHenry County Animal Control, 100 N. Virginia St. (intersection of Rt. 14 and Woodstock St), and Crystal Lake. Redemption hours are 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday (until 6:30 on Wednesday) and 8 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. on Saturday.

Animals must be claimed at MCAC within 7 business days; after that period MCAC reserves the right to transfer the animal to a rescue group or make them available for
