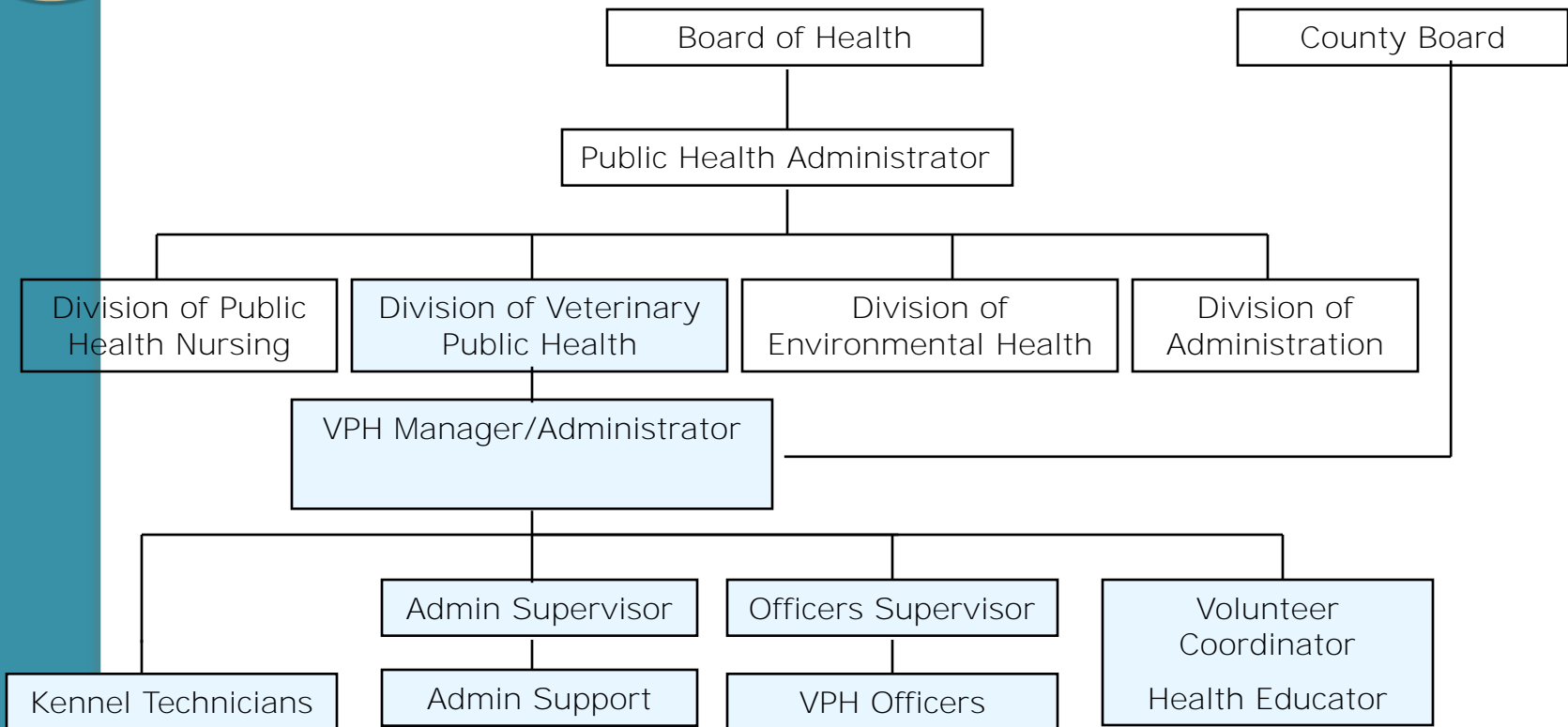


# ANIMAL CONTROL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

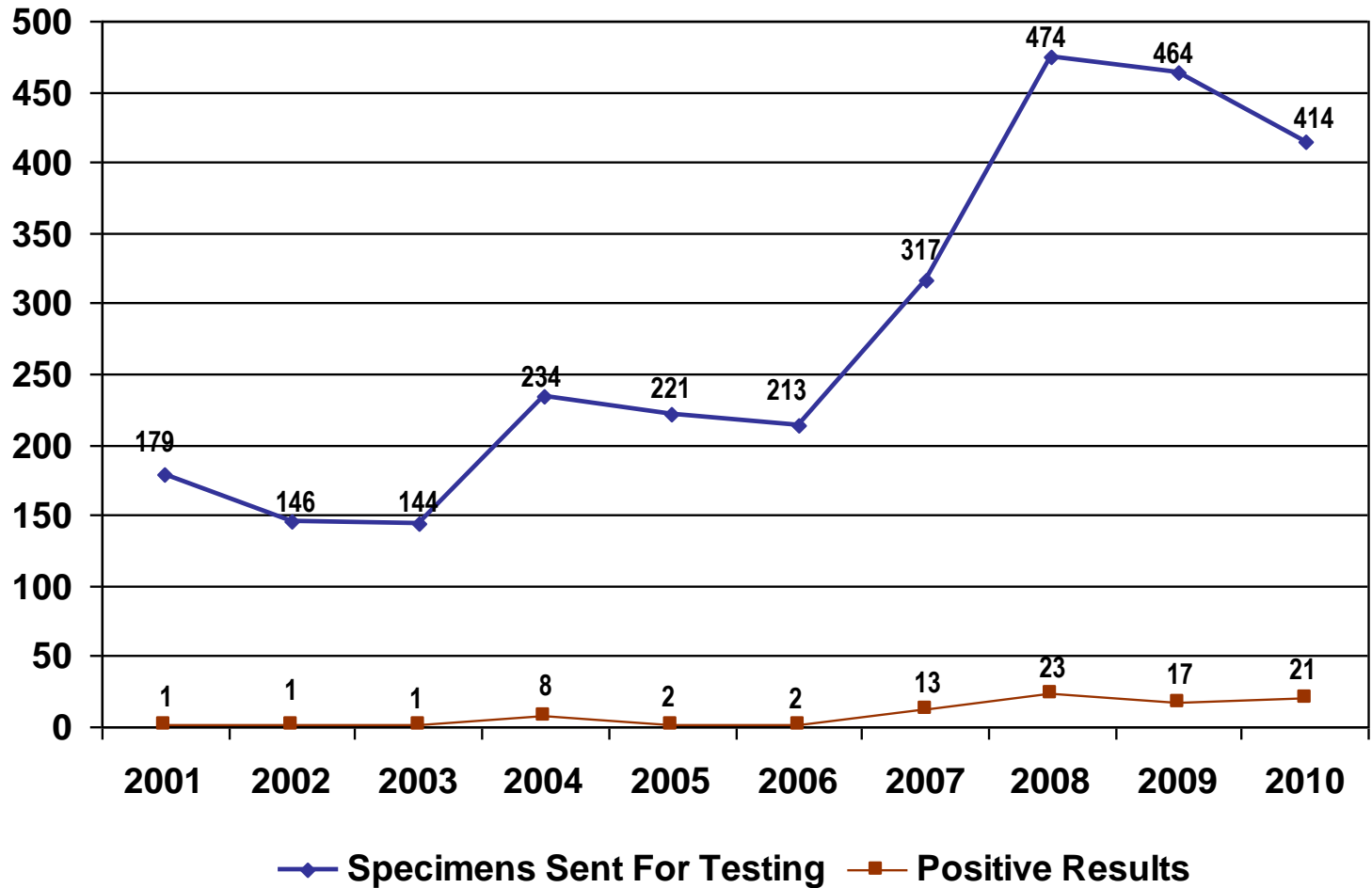
- A ten member committee, appointed by the Board of Health

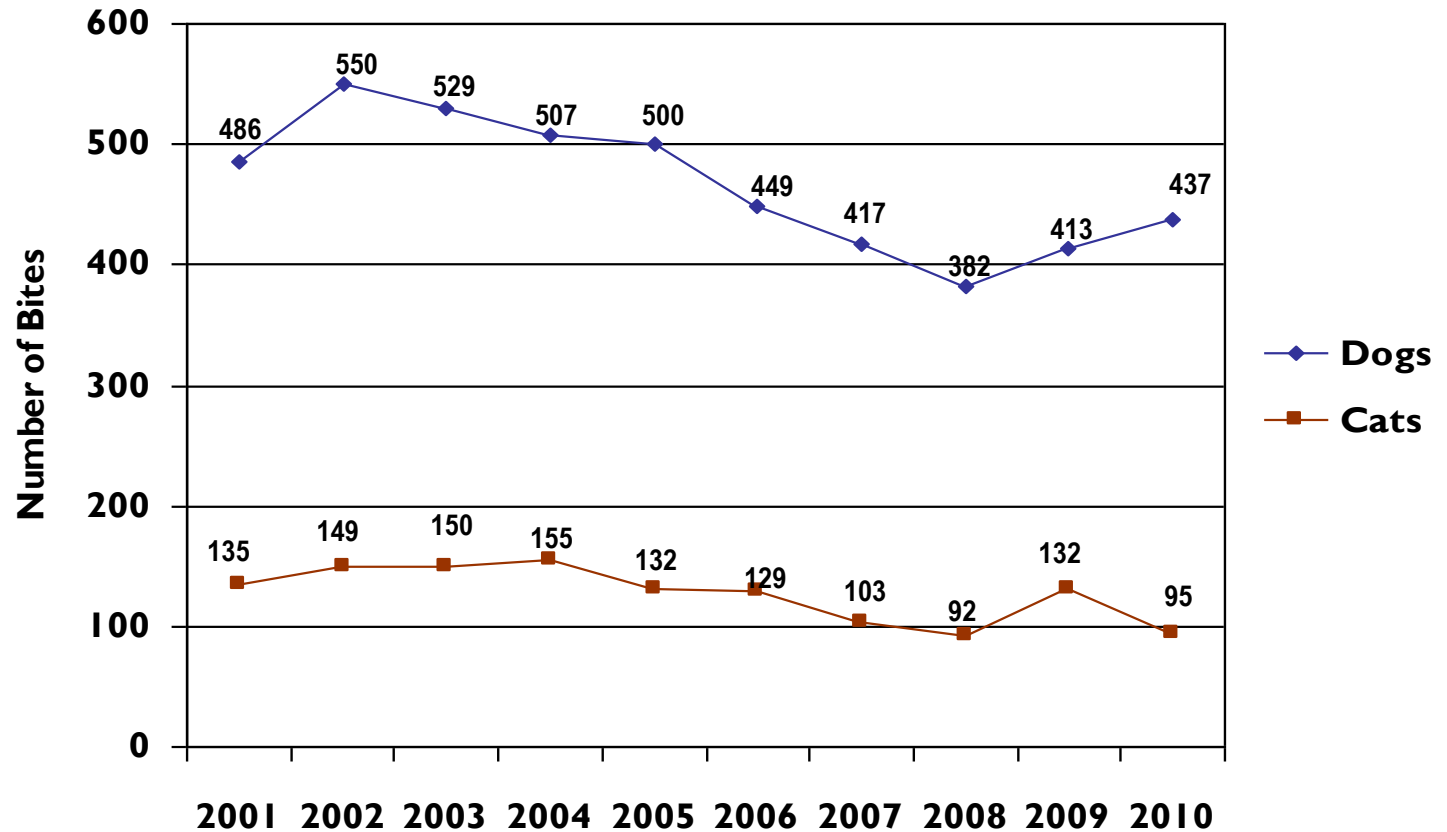

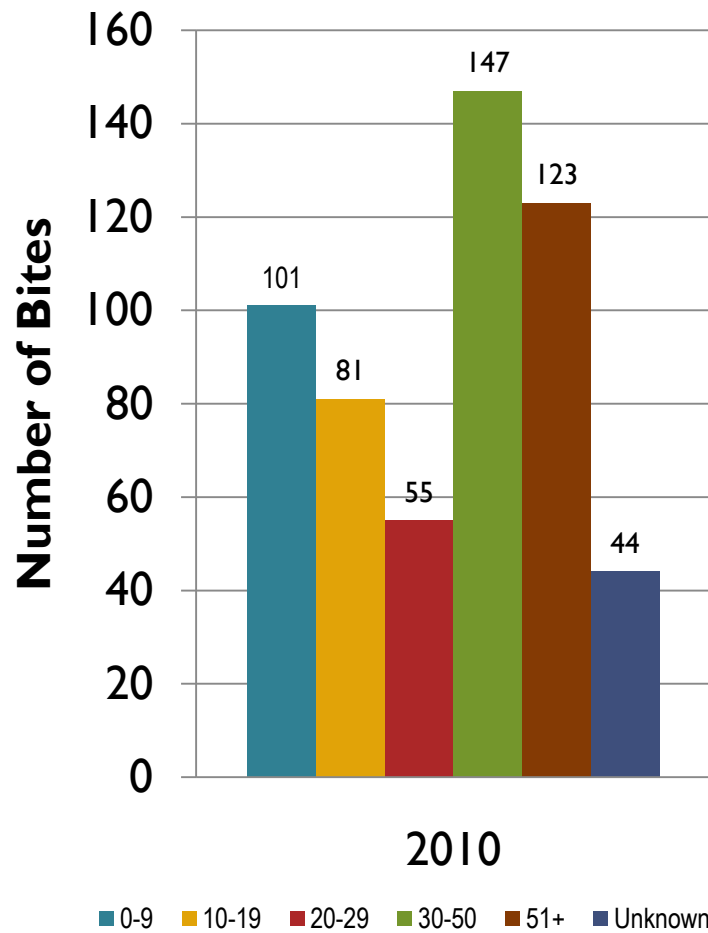
# RABIES INVESTIGATIONS



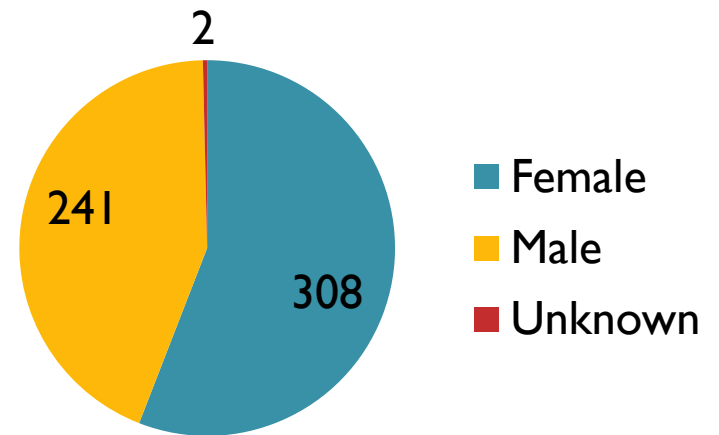
# NUMBER OF DOG AND CAT BITES IN McHENRY COUNTY 2001 – 2010



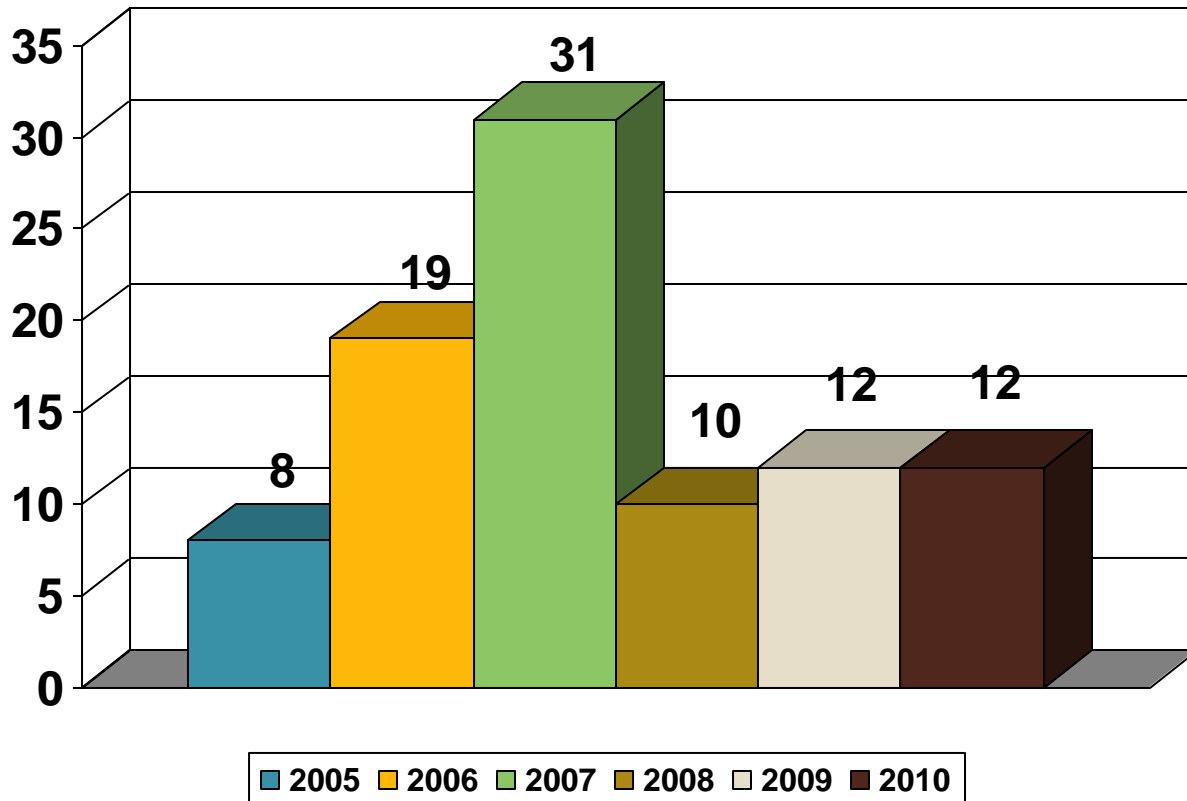
# Dog Bites - Detail



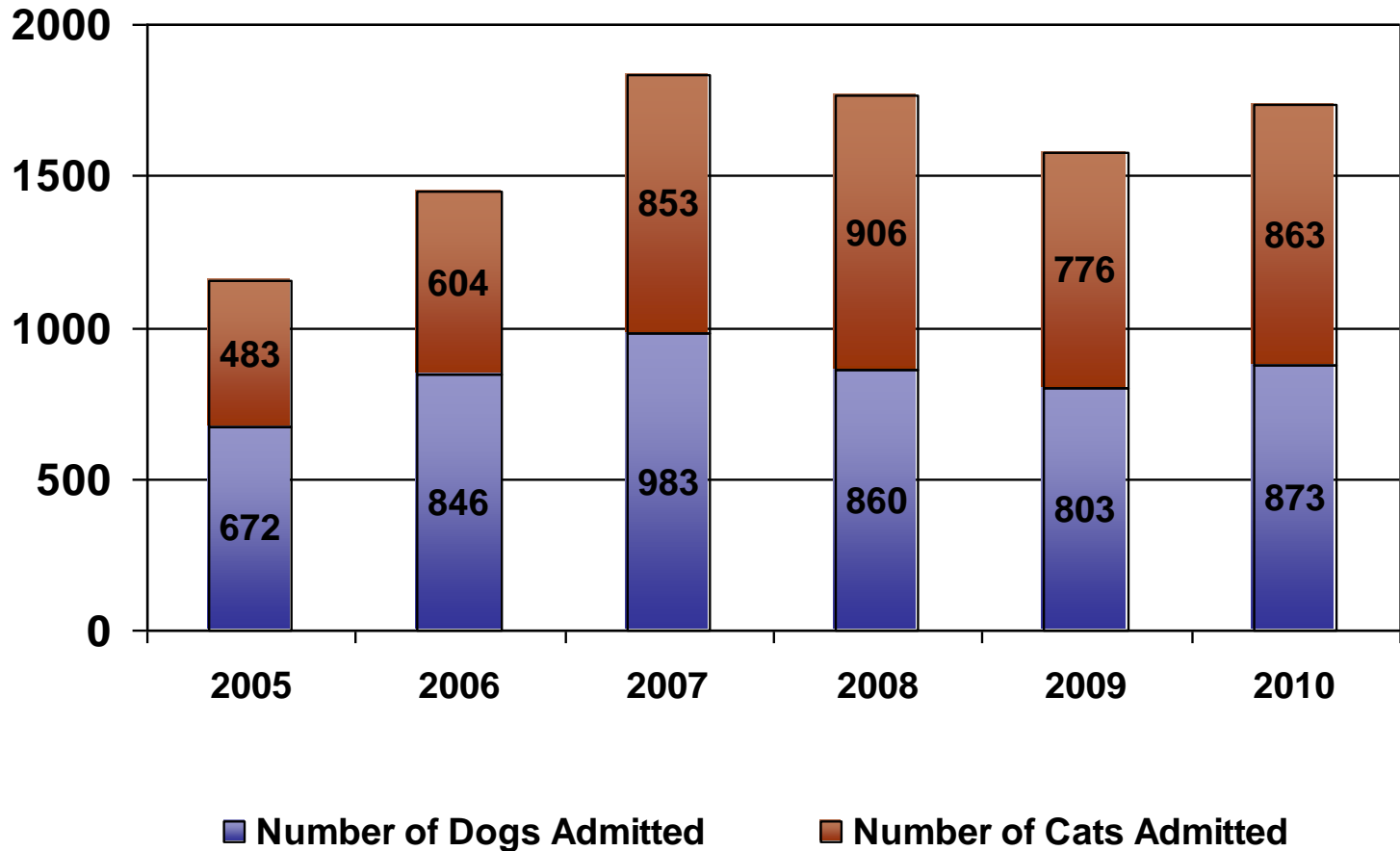

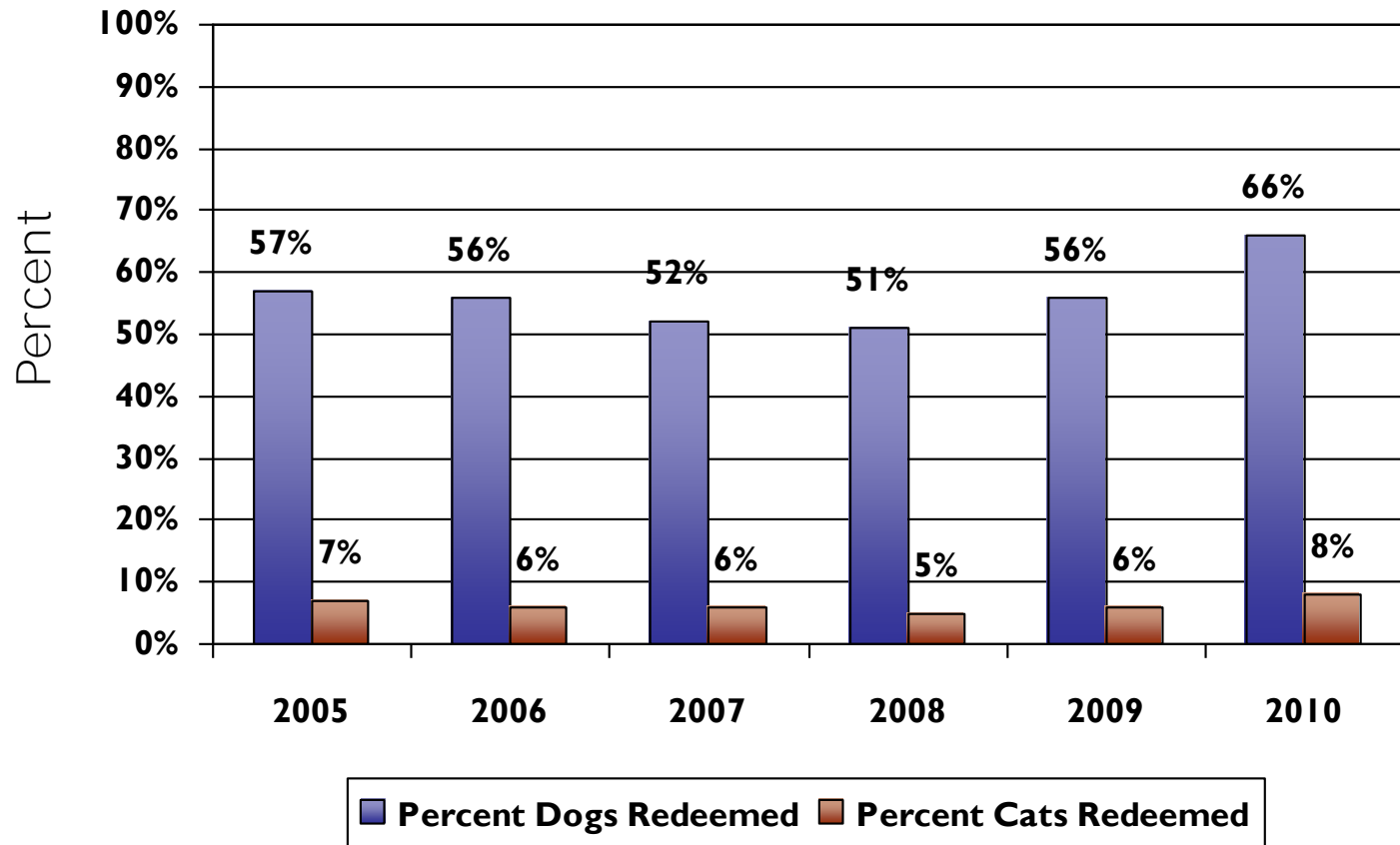
# Dogs Declared Dangerous



# TOTAL DOGS AND CATS ADMITTED TO McHENRY COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL AND ADOPTION CENTER

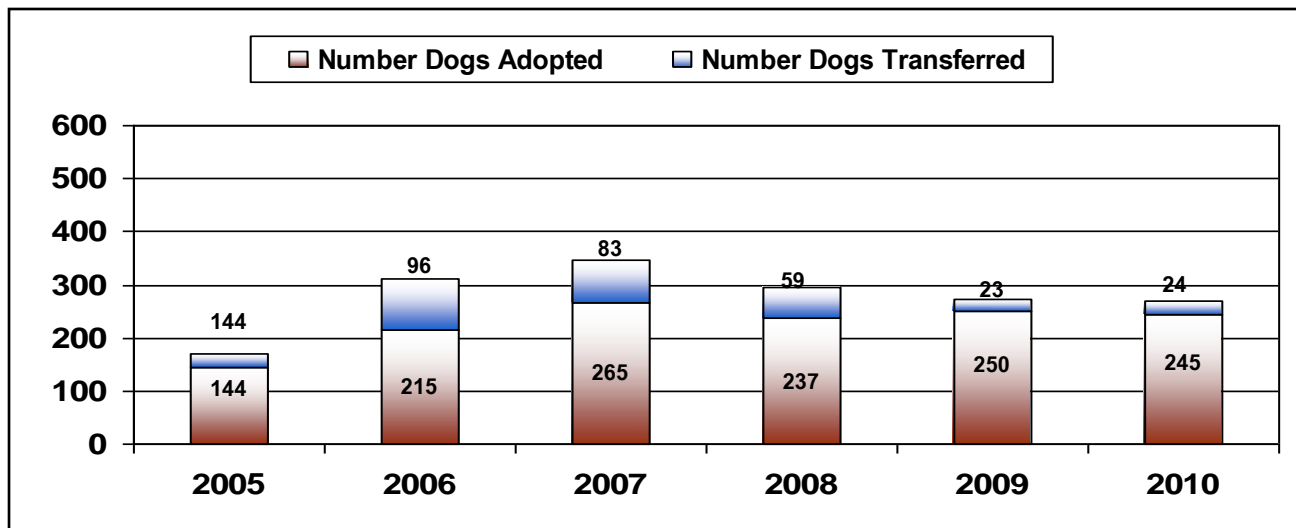


# PERCENT OF CATS AND DOGS RECLAIMED BY OWNER

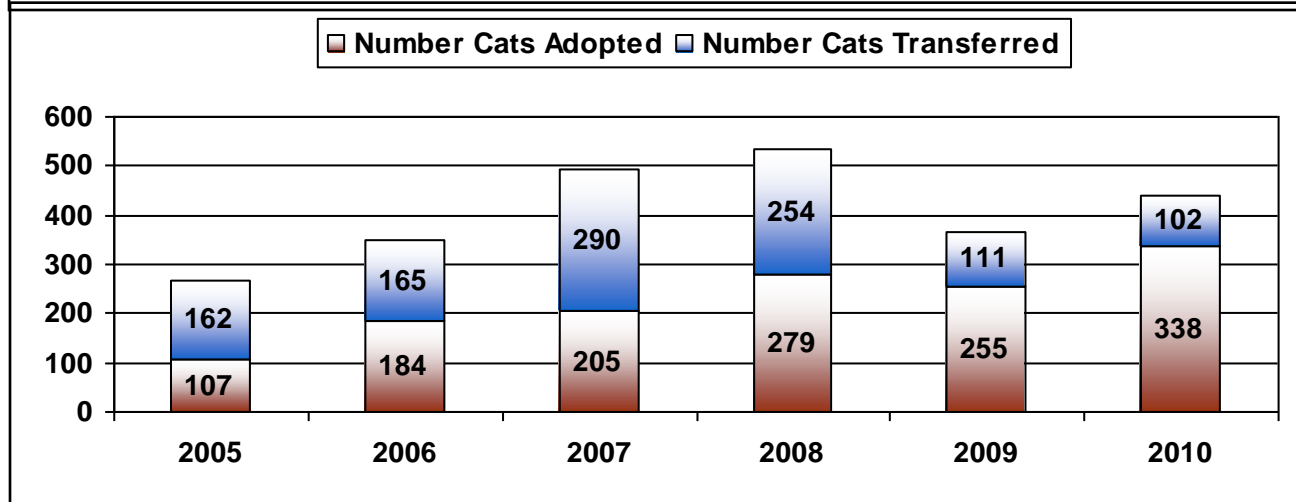


# NUMBER OF DOGS AND CATS TRANSFERRED / ADOPTED 2005 TO 2010

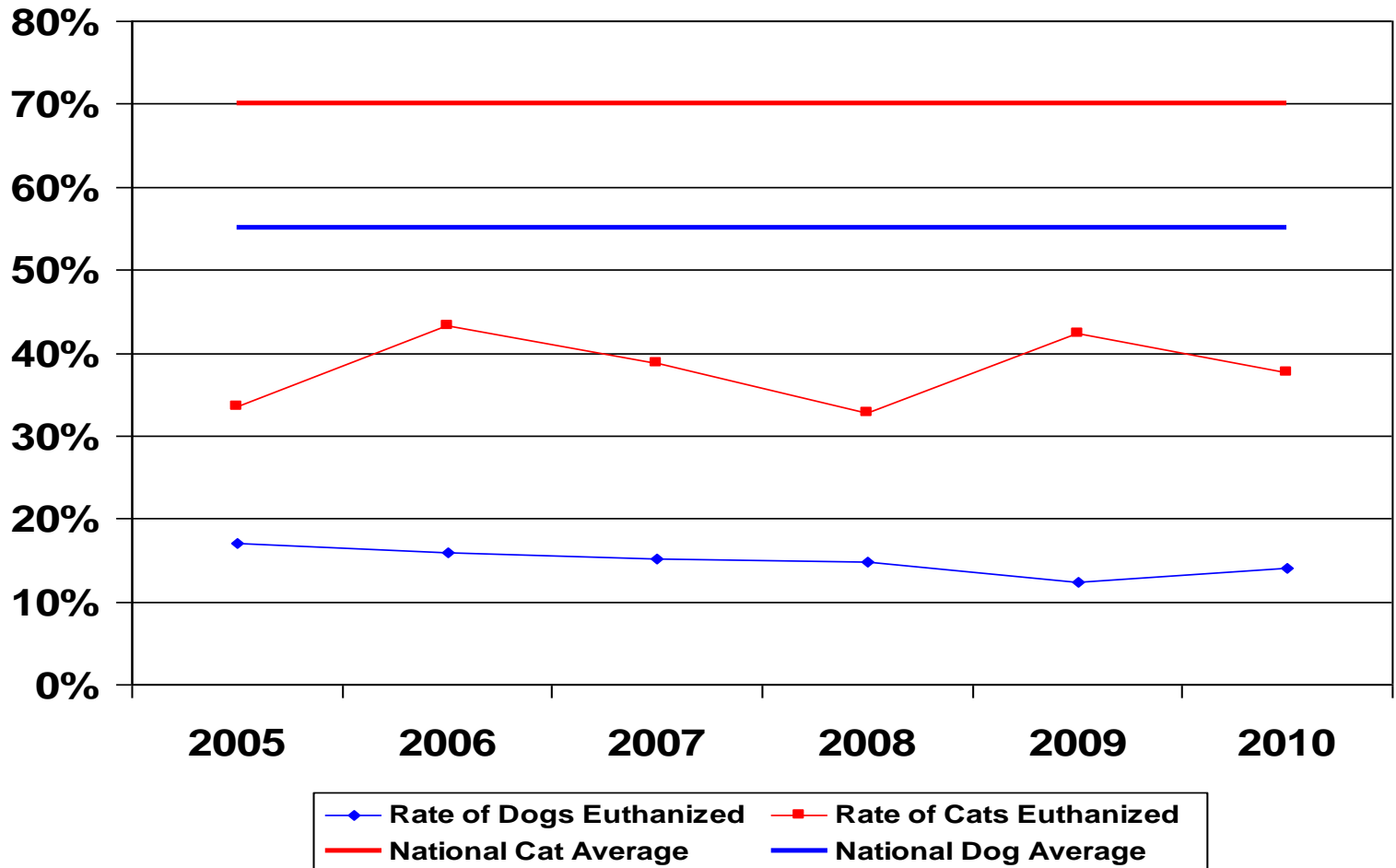

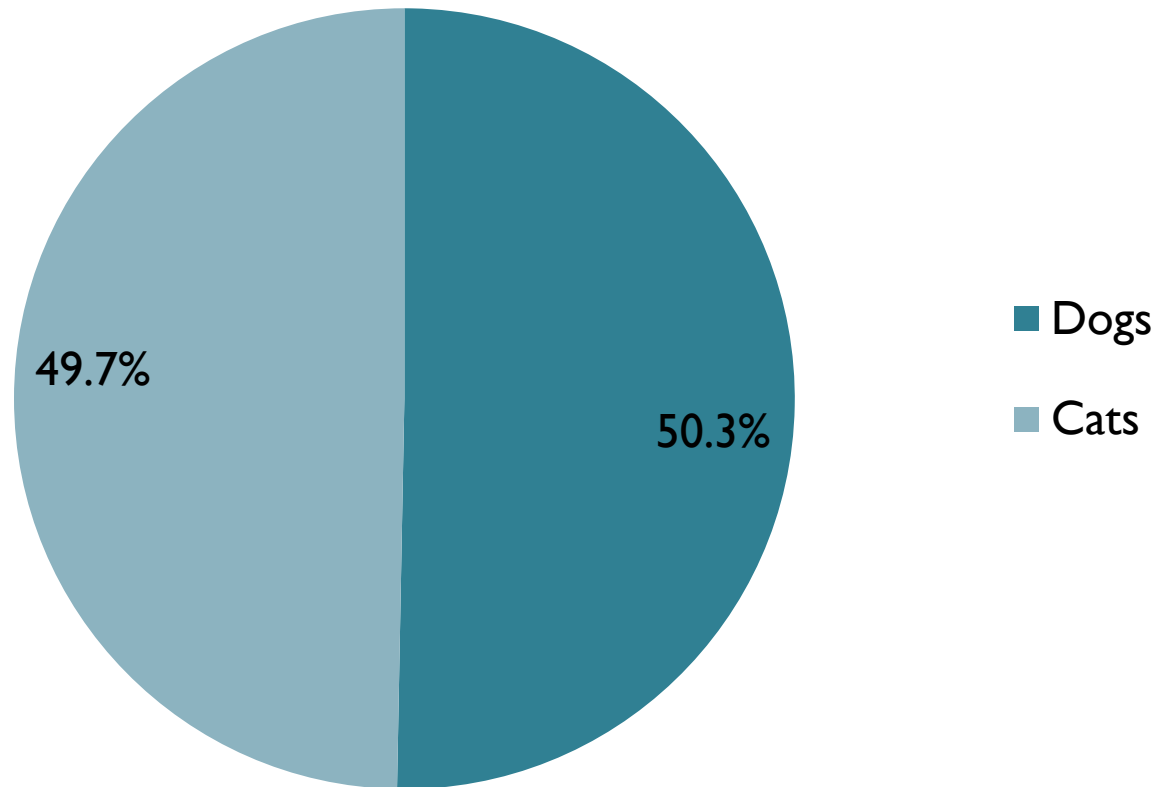

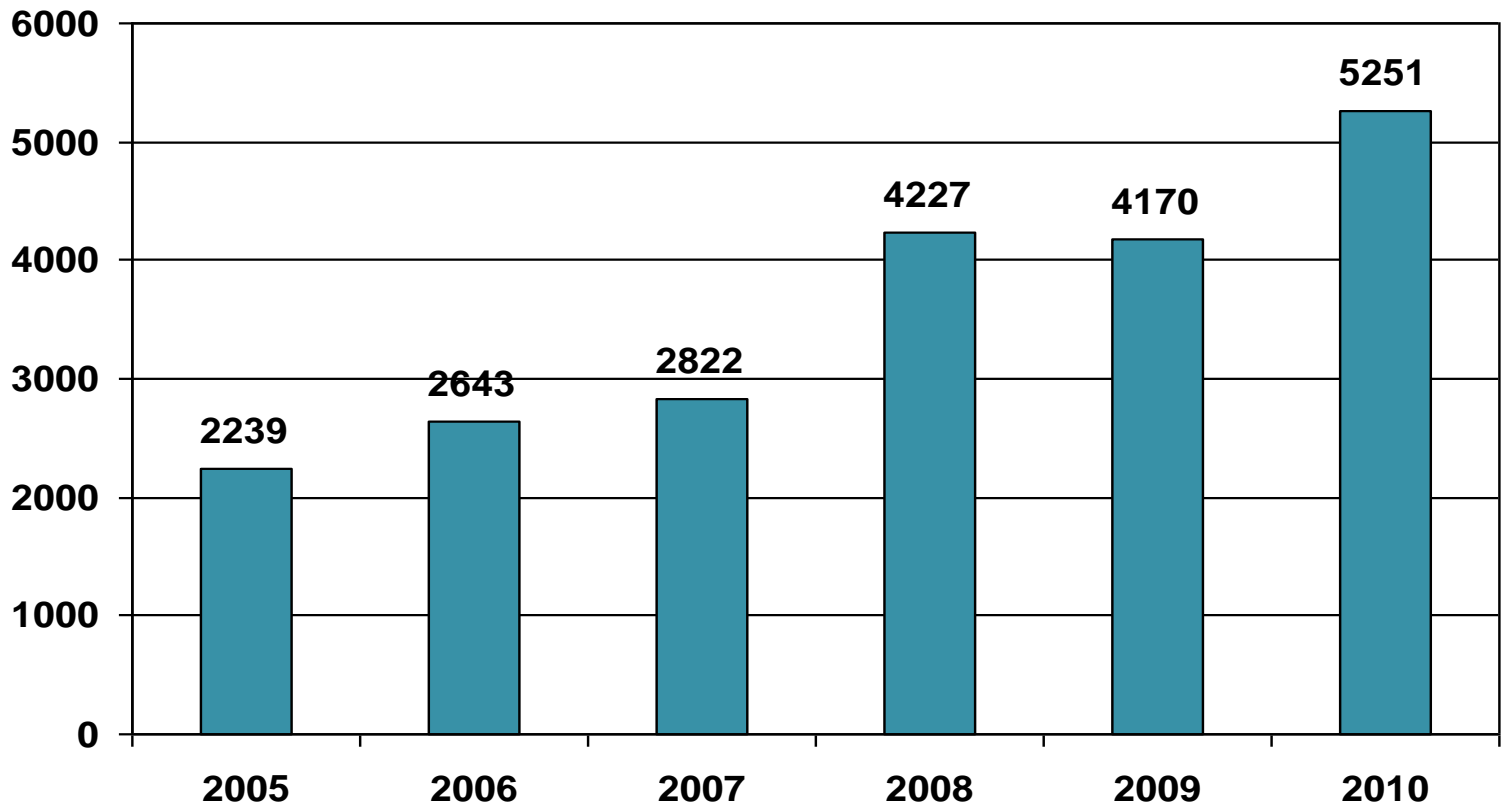
# PERCENT OF DOGS AND CATS EUTHANIZED ADMITTED INTO McHENRY COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL



# DOGS VS. CATS ADMITTED 2010

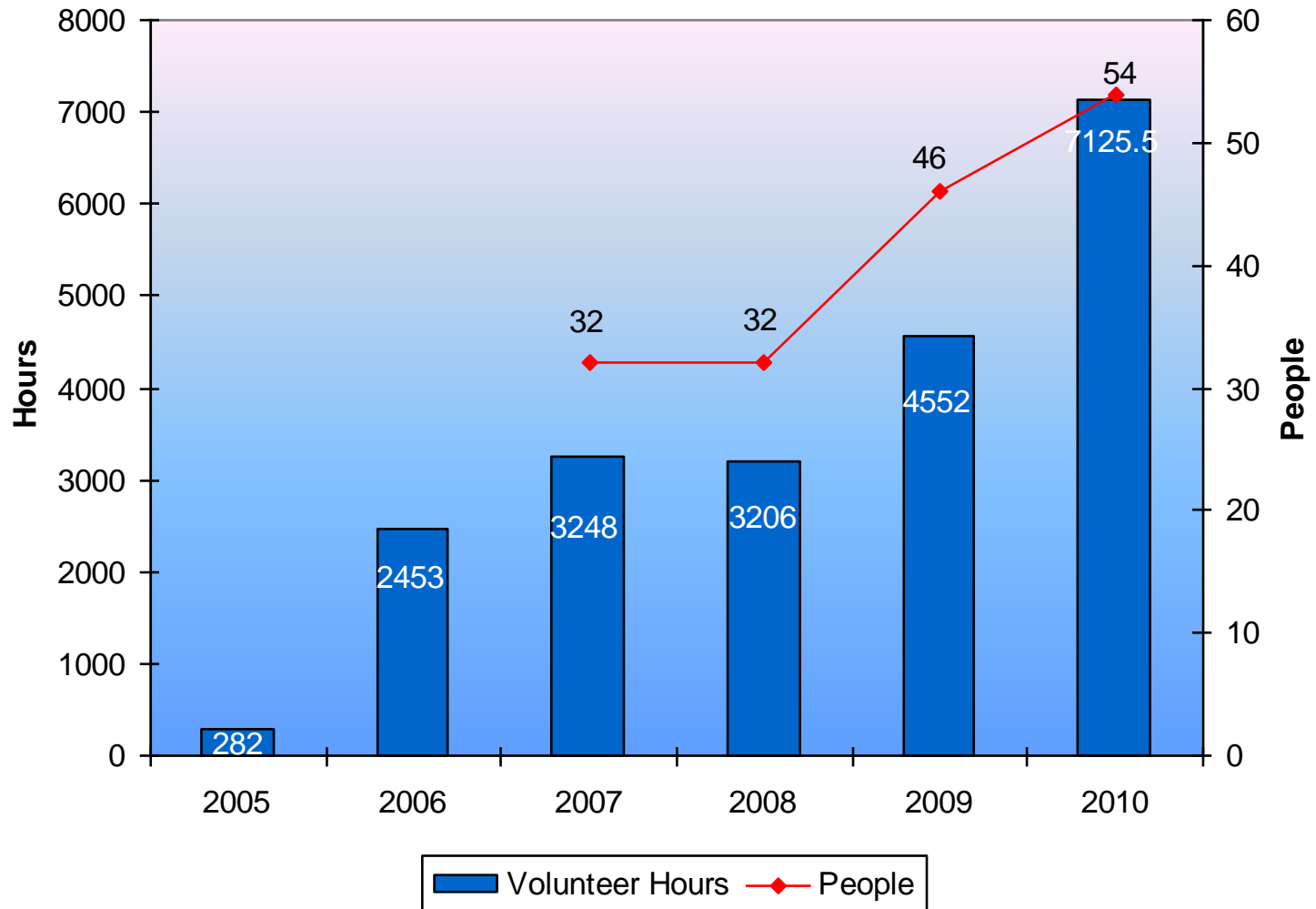


# VISITORS TO McHENRY COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL AND ADOPTION CENTER
