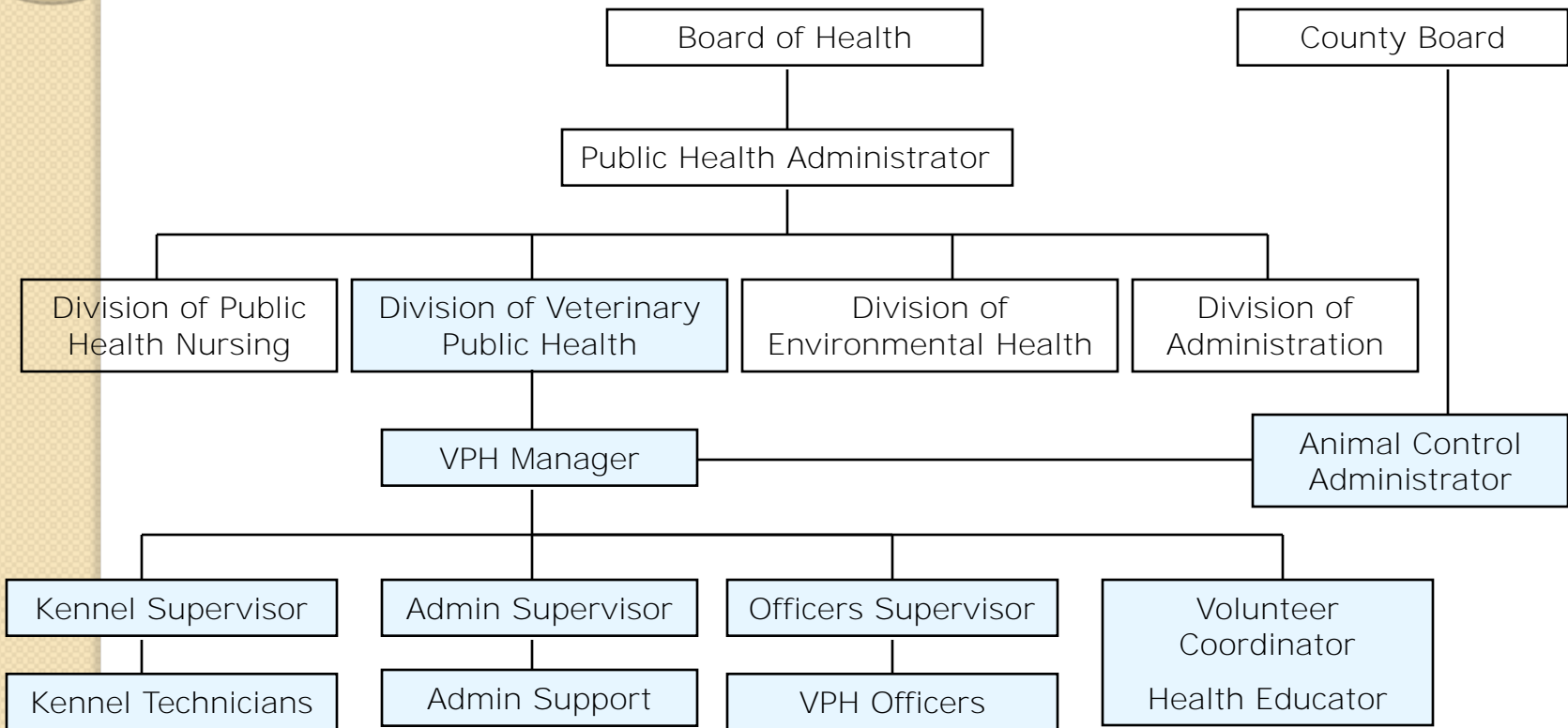

ANIMAL CONTROL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

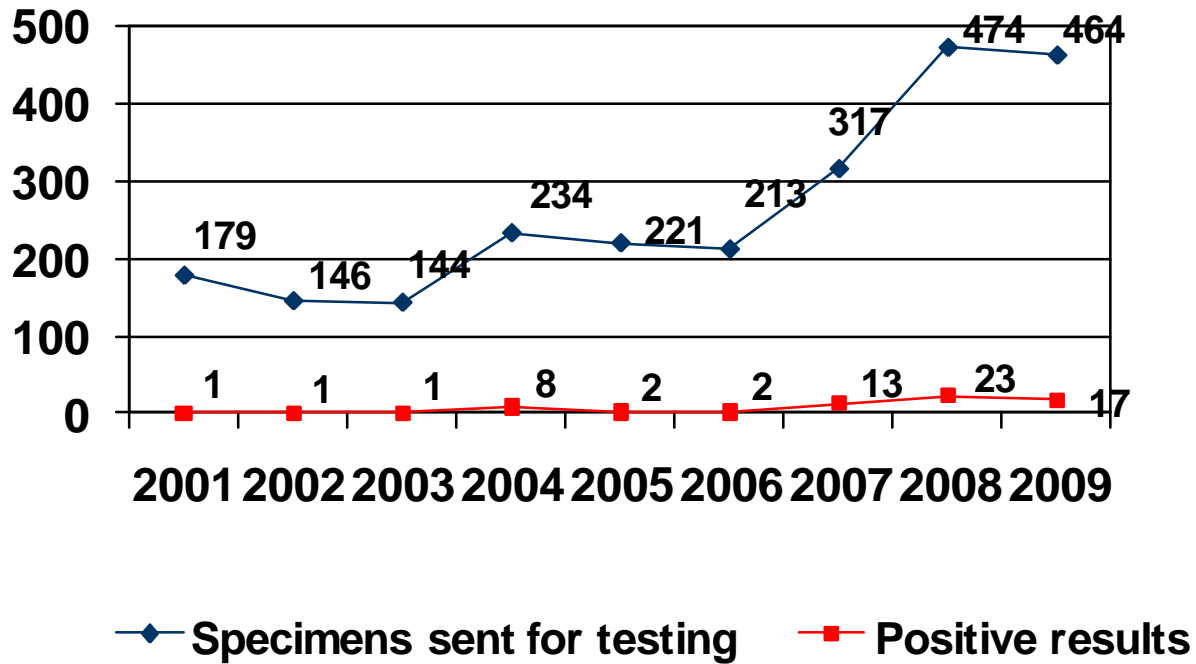
- A ten member committee, appointed by the Board of Health

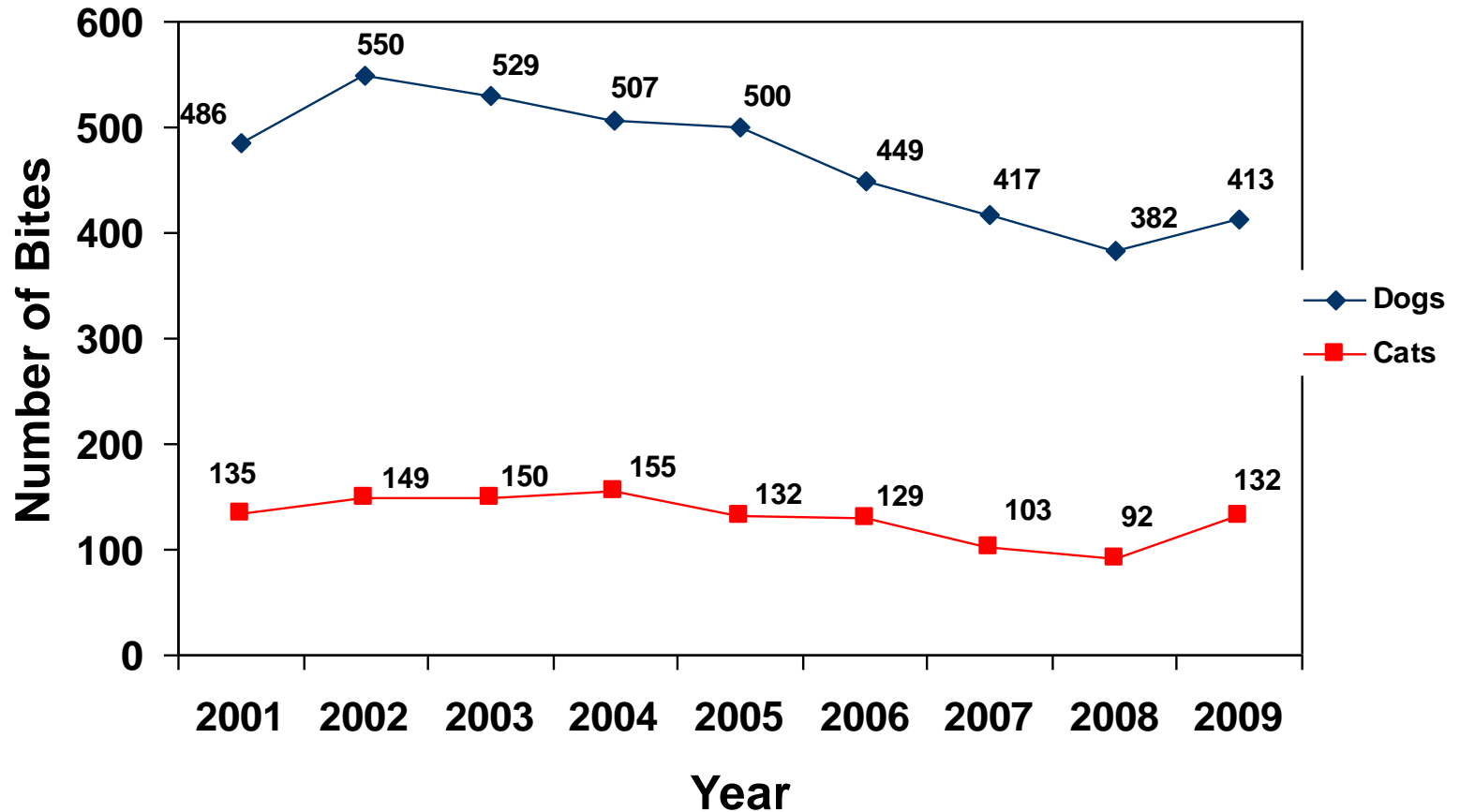

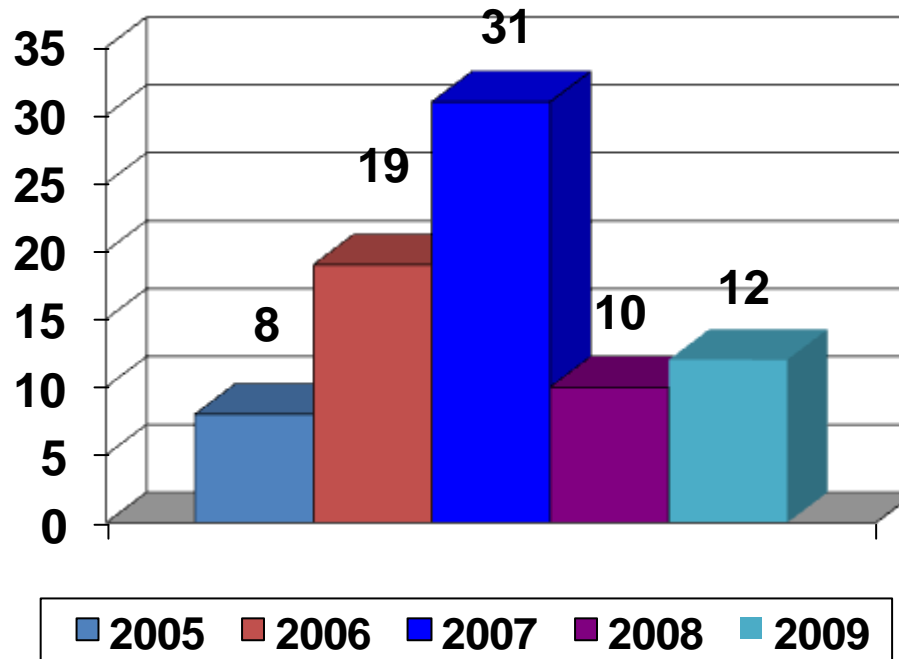
RABIES INVESTIGATIONS



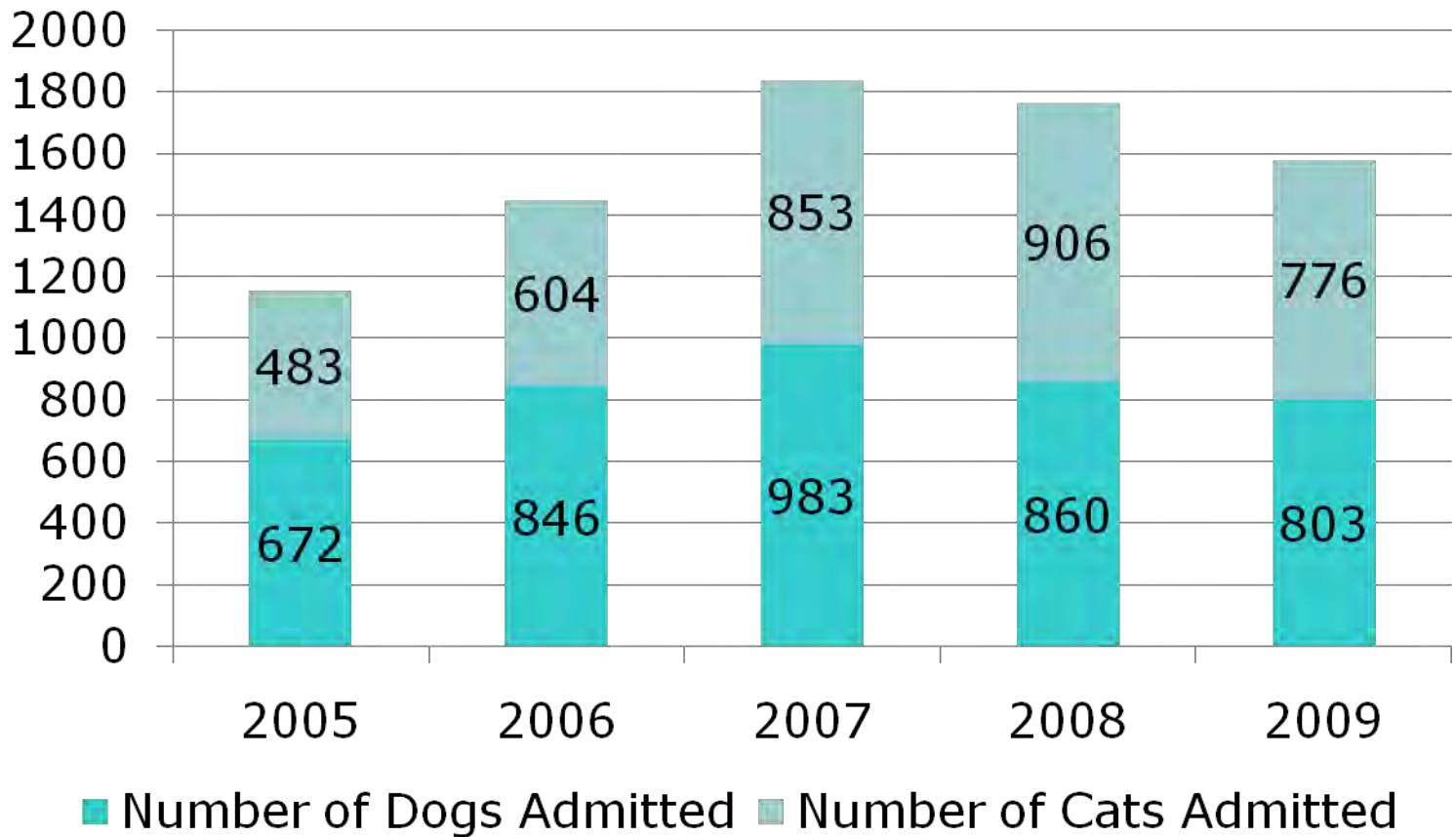
NUMBER OF DOG AND CAT BITES IN McHENRY COUNTY 2001 - 2009



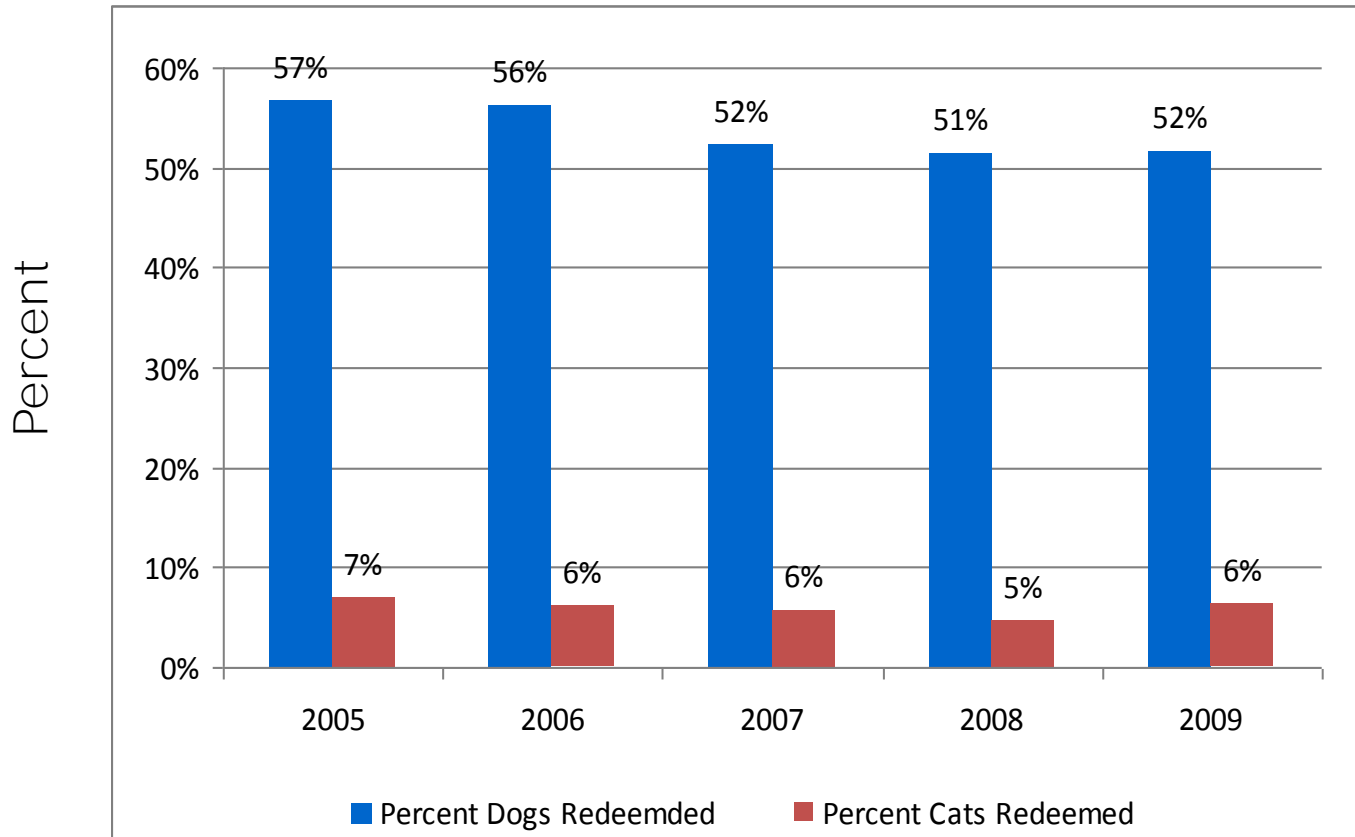
Dogs Declared Dangerous



TOTAL DOGS AND CATS ADMITTED TO McHENRY COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL AND ADOPTION CENTER

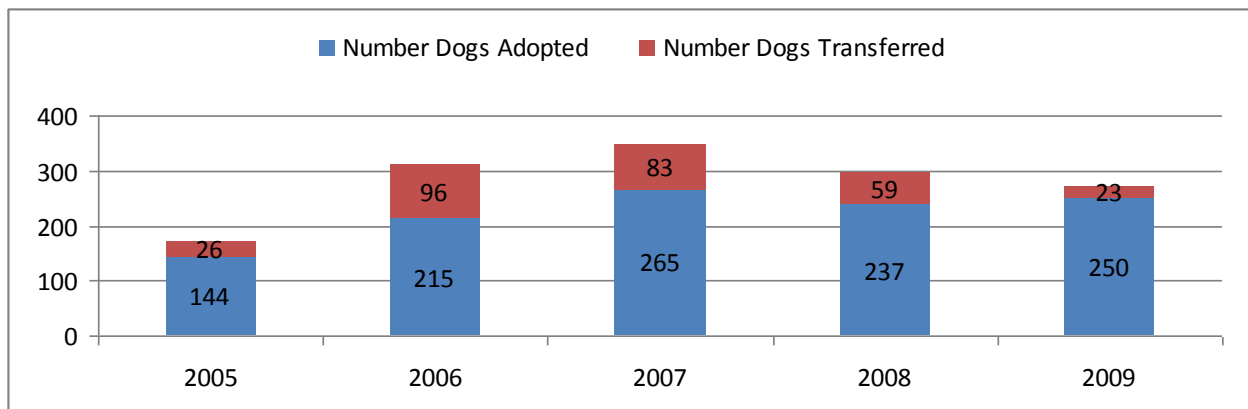


PERCENT OF CATS AND DOGS RECLAIMED BY OWNER

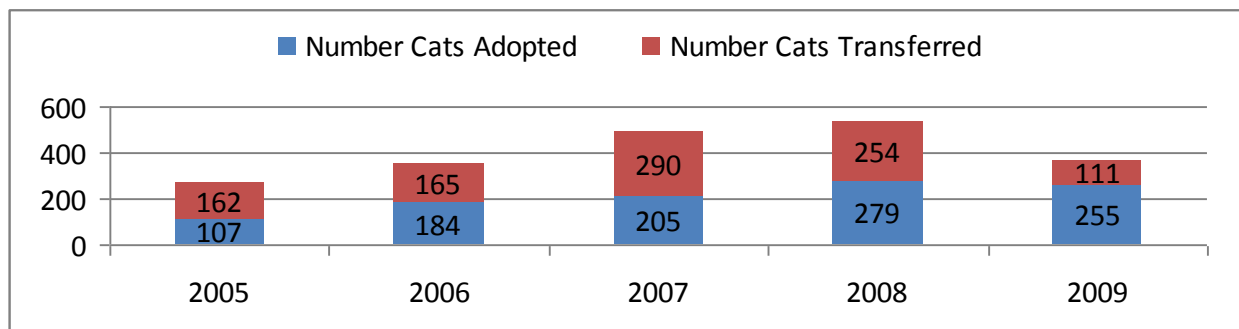


NUMBER OF DOGS AND CATS TRANSFERRED / ADOPTED 2005 TO 2009

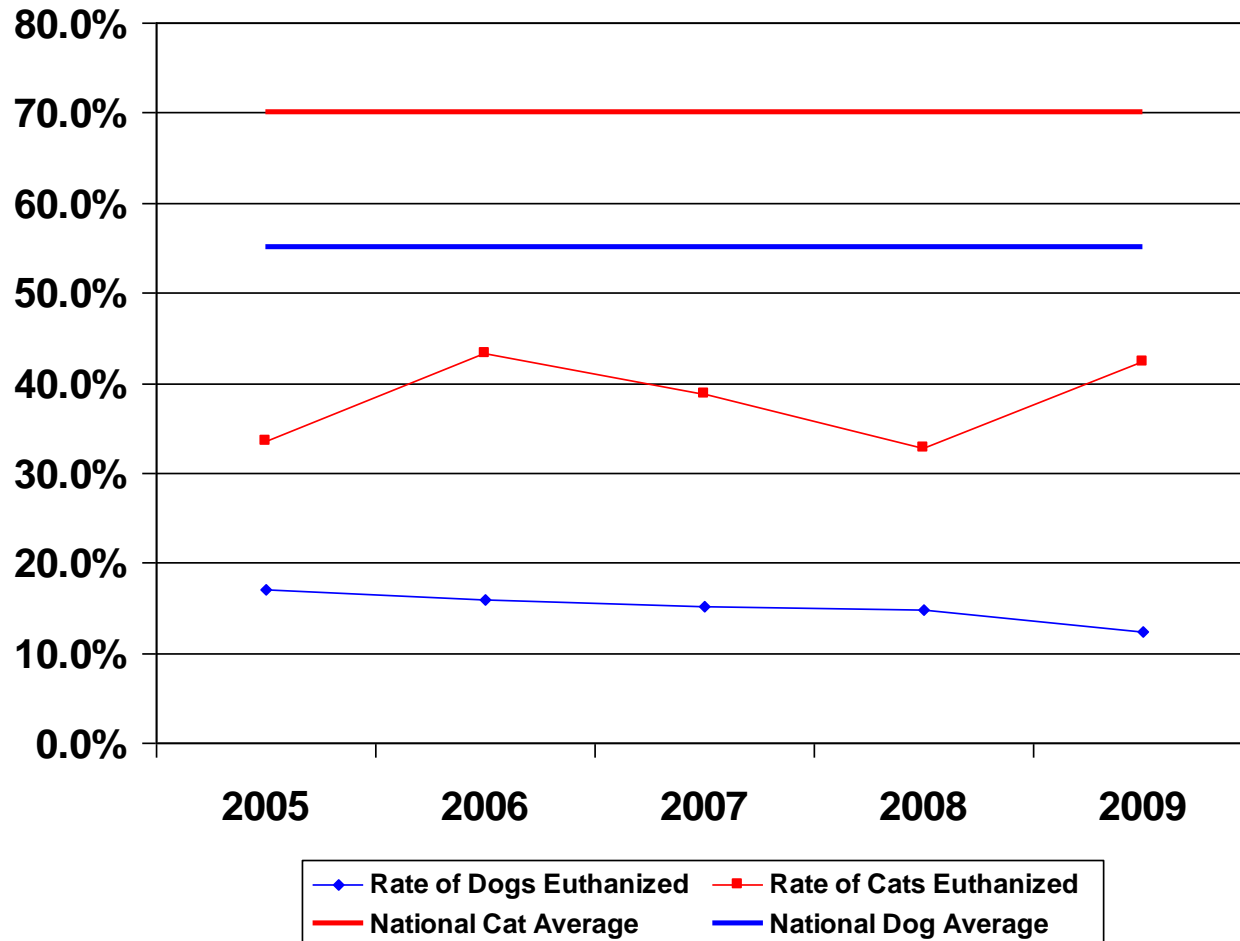

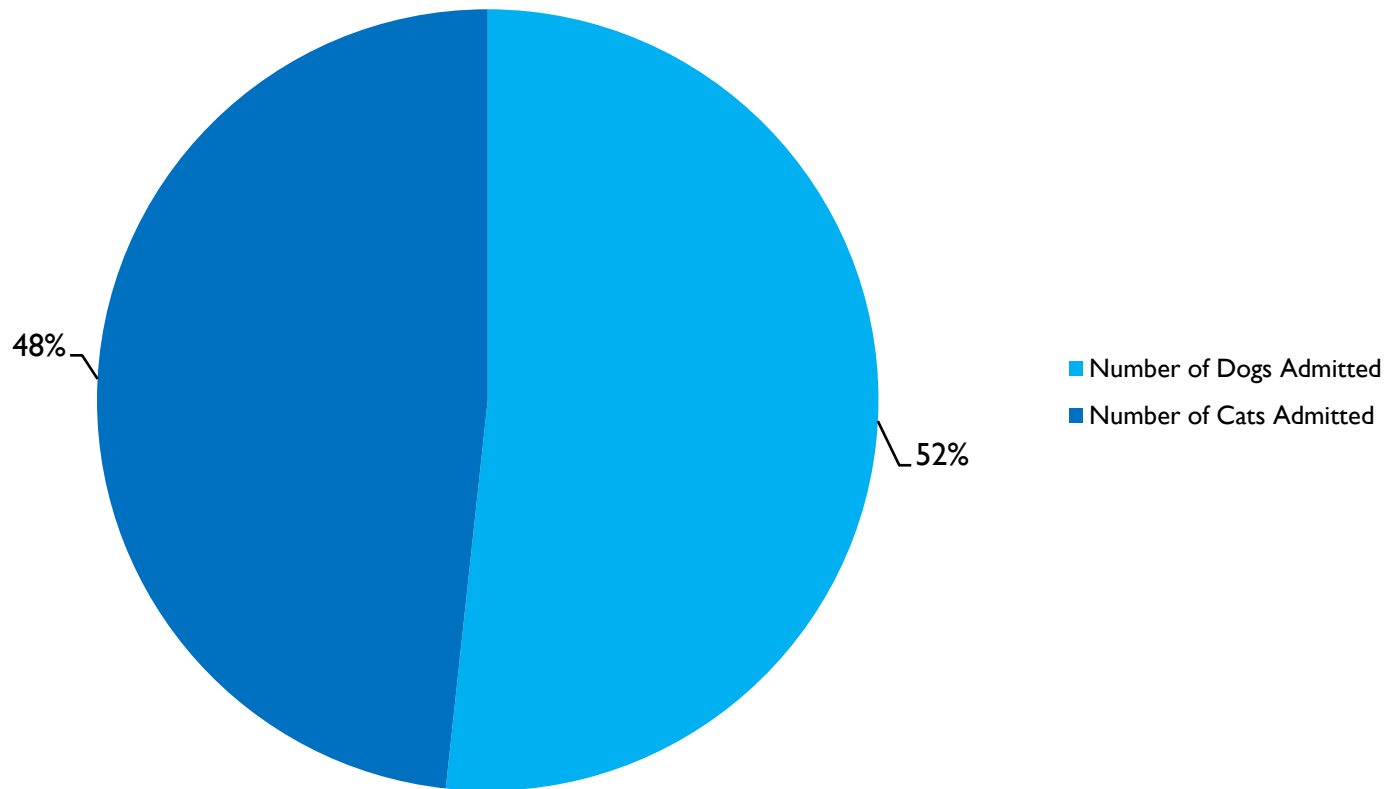

PERCENT OF DOGS AND CATS EUTHANIZED ADMITTED INTO McHENRY COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL



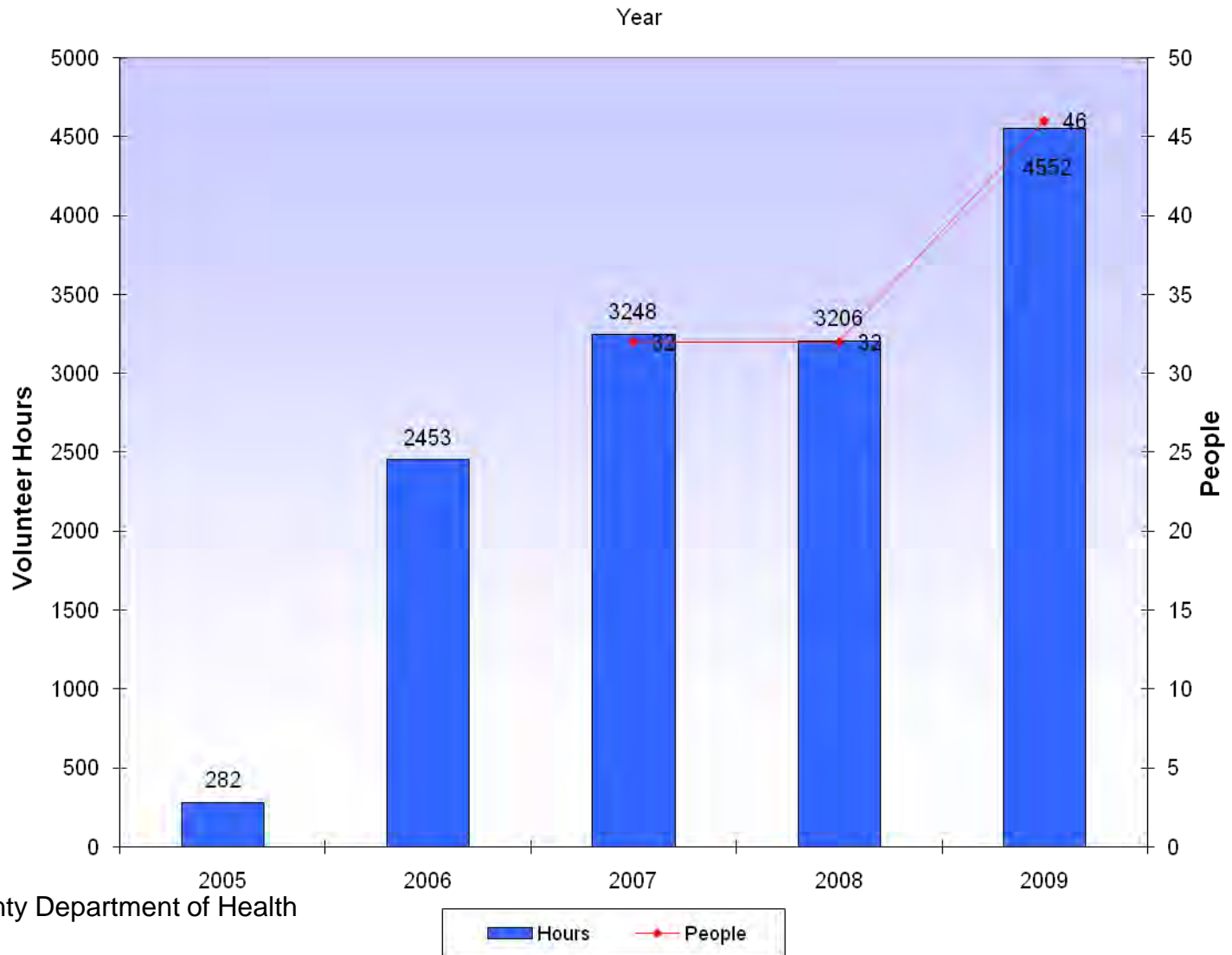
DOGS VS. CATS ADMITTED 2008/2009

Focus efforts on adoption and public education.

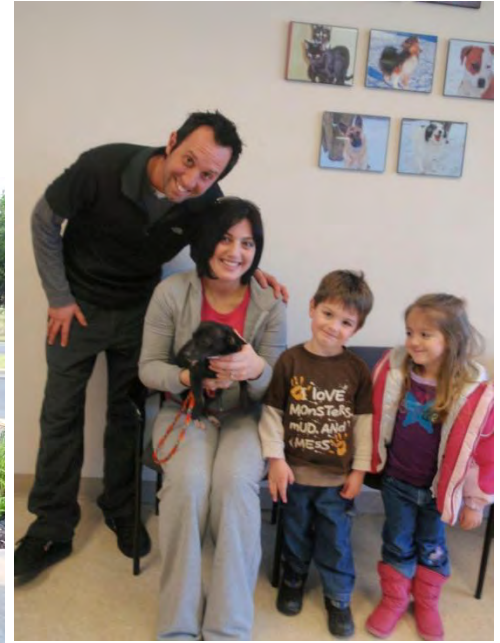
