

Valid Identification for Visitation

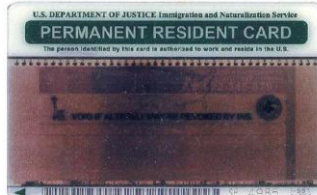
All visitors to the Jail must provide a valid form of identification. Valid identification is an instrument which allows jail staff to reasonably determine the visitor is who they identify themselves to be.

Valid identification cards include:

- State Issued Drivers License
 - State Issued Identification Card
 - United States Government Employee ID
 - Illinois Bar Association Card
 - McHenry County Employee ID Card
 - Passport
 - I-551 (lawfully admitted permanent resident, resident alien, permanent resident card).
- A birth date is not required on the photo ID unless there is a question regarding the age of the visitor.
 - Addresses are not required on identification cards for the purpose of visiting.
 - Cards with expiration dates must be valid and not expired.
 - Matricula or ID cards are not considered valid forms of identification due to the difficulty in determining forged documents.
 - All adult visitors must have a valid photo I.D. Child visitors accompanied by an adult are not required to present a photo I.D.
