Dear CDL Training Applicant:

Based on the current economic situation, feedback we have received from customers who have already received truck driver training, and feedback from other WIA program administrators in the states of Illinois and Wisconsin, we require the following for all CDL training applicants.

1. You must provide a letter of intent to hire (“pre-hire” letter) from a recognized employer stating that you will be hired upon completion of your truck driver training and submit it along with your application. Generally, the truck driver training schools will be able to guide you in this endeavor. This must be produced before your eligibility is considered.
2. You must have a clean driving record. You will need to get your driving record from the DMV, or a DAC report if you already have driving experience, and provide it when you submit your application.
3. You must be willing to drive over-the-road. You will need to gain substantial experience in over-the-road driving before most local companies will consider you for employment.
4. Ability to be insured is critical – you must be at least 21 years old for consideration as you cannot cross state lines until you are 21.
5. Ability to pass drug screening (urine testing/hair analysis) indicating you have been drug free for the past six (6) months.
6. You must be able to obtain a one-year (1 year) DOT/medical card before approval for CDL training.
