Notice for Public Review and Comment of the

2016 McHenry County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan

McHenry County, in partnership with participating jurisdictions, has completed a draft update of the County's hazard mitigation plan. The purpose of the plan is to assess natural hazards that may impact our communities and identify a strategy (i.e., projects and actions) to reduce the impact of future hazard events. Maintaining a compliant hazard mitigation plan ensures that McHenry County is eligible for all federally available mitigation-related Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) grant funding and disaster support opportunities (as set forth in the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000). Public review and comment on the draft plan is welcomed and encouraged. **Comments will be accepted until 10/28/2016.**
