

Smoke-Free Illinois Act

Public Places

- Public places where smoking is prohibited include, but are not limited to:
 - * Restaurants
 - * Bars/taverns
 - * Bowling alleys
 - * Private clubs
 - * Gaming facilities
 - * Dormitories
 - * Public conveyances
 - * Sports arenas
 - * Retail & commercial establishments
 - * Convention facilities
 - * Vehicles and buildings owned or leased by the State
 - * Not less than 75% of hotel/motel sleeping rooms
 - * Offices
 - * Hospitals

Place of Employment

- Places of employment where smoking is prohibited means any area under the control of a public or private employer that employees are required to enter, leave, or pass through during the course of employment.
 - * Offices
 - * Restrooms
 - * Conference/classrooms
 - * Break rooms
 - * Work areas
 - * Cafeterias
 - * Other common areas
