

Fiscal Year 2009/2010 Budget Highlights and Goals

County Clerk/Elections

FY2009 Highlights

- The Clerk's office is using the Statewide Voter Registration Data Base to locate duplicate voter registrations, both in and out of the County. We are then able to remove said records.
- All voting equipment has been checked for needed maintenance
- Polling sites have been confirmed for 2010
- Judge of Election files have been purged of those no longer serving
- The touch screen voting equipment and laptop operations have been moved to the Election Building on the "Klehm Property"
- The Township Maps for Voting Precincts have been added to the County Clerk's website
- The Clerk' office is now providing the mandated election history files, to the political parties, in an electronic format rather than printing on paper (a savings of approximately 120 reams of paper annually)

FY2010 Goals

- To continue to explore methods of saving money and resources

The Clerk's office will be challenged to meet the following "probable" additional election mandates
Election Bills awaiting the Governor's signature will require the following

- Grace period voting will be extended through the 7th day before an election
- Mandated early voting sites will need to be kept open at least 8 hours on holidays and 14 hours over the last weekend during the early voting period
- No-excuse absentee voting will permit a person to request and vote an absentee ballot without a reason
