### Purpose and Need

The primary purpose of this project is **improving safety** by reducing the frequency and severity of crashes in and around the Charles Road at Raffel Road intersection. The secondary purpose is **improving operations** of the intersection. Proposed alternatives were evaluated utilizing criteria such capacity, cost, impacts, crash analysis and other qualitative factors.

### Public Coordination

**Today's meeting** will present the purpose of the project, outline the existing project conditions, explain the project process, obtain **public ideas/comments** regarding the proposed project as well as input on the proposed alternatives that are presented here today.

### Phase I and II Engineering

This project includes a **Phase I Study** wherein data is collected and reviewed. Alternatives for the improvements have been developed and analyzed. During the **Phase II Design**, detailed construction plans will be developed for the selected improvement alternative.

### Land Acquisition

Alternatives have been developed to avoid and **minimize impacts to adjacent property**, however, the acquisition of right-of-way or easements may still be required. MCDOT will follow the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (Federal Uniform Act).

### Construction

Construction is scheduled to begin in 2014.
