INSTRUCTIONS TO SHERIFF

The sheriff shall post three (3) copies of the notice in three (3) public places in the neighborhood of the court where the cause is to be tried, at least ten (10) days prior to the day set for the appearance, and, if the place of residence of the defendant is stated in any affidavit on file, shall at the same time mail one (1) copy of the notice addressed to such defendant at such place of residence shown in such affidavit. On or before the day set for the appearance, the sheriff shall file the notice with an endorsement thereon stating the time when and places where he posted and to whom and at what address he mailed copies as required by this Section. For want of sufficient notice, any cause may be continued from time to time until the Court has jurisdiction of the defendant.
