


ANIMAL CONTROL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- A ten member committee, appointed by the Board of Health
- Mission: To provide a state of the art facility and services that will address needs of an expanding community and in a collaborative manner to:
 - 1) Promote animal welfare and adoption.
 - 2) Provide public education and safety.
 - 3) Prevent disease transmission from animals to humans.






Emergency Response

- MCAC is part of the team for coordinating the Department's response to potential or actual natural or man-made Public Health disasters, including chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and/or explosive event(s), and providing 24/7 availability, should the event occur within McHenry County.
 - People refuse evacuation if animals must be left behind
- VPH manager has level II USDA accreditation for responding to bioterrorism and foreign animal diseases.
- VPH manager has expertise in zoonotic diseases.






All Registered Dogs by Year








% Strays redeemed by owners



Euthanasia Rate






Dogs Declared Dangerous


Number of Dogs


