FY2011 Highlights

- Appointment of Phillip Dailing as Director following the retirement of Phillip Ulmer who served as Director for nearly 20 years
- Retirement of Administrative Assistant Susan Vance after 41 years of service
- Retirement of Adult Supervisor Cynthia Rankin after 26 year of service
- Finalization of plans for implementing the 22nd Circuit Drug Court
- 45,406 hours of community service ordered and 32,814 hours completed as of June 25, 2011
- \$442,897 in restitution collected to be paid to crime victims in calendar year 2010
