

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2011-16
22ND JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
McHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

**ORDER CLOSING ALL COURTS FOR JUDICIAL TRAINING DAY
ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 18, 2012**

There having been a determination by the Circuit Judges of the 22ND Judicial Circuit that additional training for Judges, court personnel, and others working in the justice system in McHenry County, Illinois, concerning the principles and practices of effective case-flow management would be beneficial to the administration of justice in the 22ND Judicial Circuit; and the date of Wednesday, January 18, 2012, (8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.) having been set for the presentation of a Caseflow Management Seminar;

THEREFORE, pursuant to the general administrative authority over the 22ND Judicial Circuit, including the authority to establish the times and places of holding Court, granted to the Chief Judge in Article VI, Section 7(c) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois and in Illinois Supreme Court Rule 21(b);

IT IS ORDERED that, except as otherwise provided in this Order, all courtrooms in the 22nd Judicial Circuit shall be closed all day on Wednesday, January 18, 2012, for the purpose of allowing all Judges and court personnel to attend a Caseflow Management Seminar presented at the McHenry County Government Center on said date;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the First Appearance and Bond Court in the McHenry County Correctional Facility shall be in session on January 18, 2012, as usual;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that emergency matters, including but not limited to, presentation of Petitions for Emergency Orders of Protection and other types of petitions seeking similar relief, issuance of warrants, and all other emergency matters, shall be heard at break times during the Caseflow Management Seminar by the Duty Judge and/or other assigned Judges.
