### Truancy Summary

The Regional Office of Education continued to work with each local school district to pursue the county attendance initiative.

During the past year, the Regional Office received **178** referrals while continuing **70** cases from the previous year.

### Facilities Program

The Regional Office of Education oversaw and supervised all major school construction and renovation projects in the County. Services delivered included, plan review in conjunction with Planning and Development, permitting, construction inspections and acting as a liaison between local districts and government authorities. Two elementary and two middle schools came on-line this fiscal year.

### Professional Development

The Regional Office of Education continues to play a key role in the professional development of McHenry County educators. Through the Kishwaukee Intermediate Delivery System (K.I.D.S.), the McHenry County Regional Office, in cooperation with the Dekalb and Boone/Winnebago Regional Offices provides staff development opportunities for all of the certified educators of McHenry County. This past year, **560** educators received professional development from K.I.D.S.
