Dr. Styer has been published in the *Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Mental Health, Journal of Cognitive Psychotherapy, Psychiatry Research and The Prevention Researcher.* She has coauthored chapters in Grossman & Walfish's *Translating Psychological Research Into Practice* and Claes & Muehlenkamp's *Non-Suicidal Self-Injury in Eating Disorders: Advancements in Etiology and Treatment.* Dr. Styer is a co-author of the book, *Self-Injury: Simple Answers to Complex Questions.*
