Two Keynote Presentations:

“Breaking the Sound of Silence,” Camille Paddock, Adrian Nuño, and Andrew Nuño

Camille Paddock is the founder of Cam's Dare To Be Different, a non-profit organization that focuses on spreading awareness about the harmful effects of bullying as well as teen suicide. As a public speaker for the past four years, Camille shares her personal story to inspire, educate, and empower people of all ages to take a stand against bullying. She has been the recipient of numerous awards, including The Everyday Hero Award given by The Northwest Herald. Camille is a senior in high school. She plans to attend college next fall to study Psychology.

Adrian and Andrew Nuño are award-winning filmmakers from Crystal Lake. They are strong advocates for suicide prevention and awareness. Currently, Adrian and Andrew attend DePaul University in Chicago studying digital cinema. Adrian and Andrew will present their slam poem video, "All Too Soon," along with the video's actors Sam Prather and Erika Oesau.

“Inpatient Psychiatric Treatment and Medication: Matching Treatment with Need,” Dr. McMasters

Elizabeth McMasters, MD is a psychiatrist on staff with Centegra Healthcare System. Dr. McMasters received her MD in psychiatry from Northwestern University. She has been practicing as a board certified psychiatrist for more than 20 years in McHenry County. Dr. McMasters has been very instrumental in developing collaborative relationships with agencies, clinicians, patients and families, providing the framework around which best treatment outcomes are built.
