#### Additions & Clarifications to RFP/Bid

<b>Question #1:</b>	The RFQ states that the County maintains 525 lane-miles of roadway. Could the County provide how many mainline (centerline) miles the county has and what percentage of the roadway network is 4-lanes and/or divided streets or highways?
<b>Response #1:</b>	<p><b>1) Center Line Miles, approximately 216</b></p> <p><b>2) 4 lane or more, divided/undivided, percentage by center line mile: approximately 8%</b></p>
<b>Question #2:</b>	<p>Under the “<u>Project Description &amp; Scope</u>” section of the RFQ, it is stated that the County requires pavement inspection to follow 3 different inspection methodologies (Illinois DOT Condition Rating Survey, National Performance Management Measure for Assessing Pavement Condition, and Pavement Condition Index).</p> <p>a. Could the county clarify if data from all 3 different inspection methods will be loaded in to the County PMS?</p> <p>b. Could the county confirm if the Pavement Condition Index is expected to be calculated based on the ASTM D6433 standard?</p> <p>c. Could the County describe how the 3 different pavement inspection results are expected to be used to make Capital Program decisions?</p>
<b>Response #2:</b>	<p><b>A) Only the CRS data.</b></p> <p><b>B) Yes</b></p> <p><b>C) The County, in the Project Description and Scope, identifies the “Condition Rating System (CRS)” is to be utilized.</b></p>
<b>Question #3:</b>	Would the County consider amending the “ <u>Hold Harmless Clause</u> ” on Page 5 of the RFQ to specify that the Professional will indemnify the County for negligent acts or omissions caused only on the part of the Professional?
<b>Response #3:</b>	<b>No.</b>
<b>Question #4:</b>	The RFQ requires all collected data to be compatible with PavementView and PavementView+ of the Cartegraph Software Suite (version 8.4). Cartegraph no longer issues subscription for the Navigator software. Does McHenry County use Cartegraph Navigator or Cartegraph OMS? Please advise.
