

Water Conservation

Although the groundwater available for our community is adequate to meet our current needs, groundwater is a very precious natural resource that needs to be preserved and protected. Our water supply is not unlimited and residents need to carefully control and limit their use of this resource just as residents need to respect and conserve other natural resources. Water conservation and wise use of this precious asset is the responsibility of every resident.

In an effort to delay or eliminate the need for mandatory water restrictions, the City is requesting the help and cooperation of every resident and business. All water customers are asked to follow an even/odd watering schedule for all outside use. Property addresses ending in an even number (0, 2, 4, 6, and 8) should only use outside water on even numbered calendar days and then only during the hours of 6PM and 9AM. Property addresses ending in an odd number (1, 3, 5, 7, and 9) should only use outside water on odd numbered calendar days and then only during the hours of 6PM and 9AM.

In addition, residents are encouraged to take other measures to reduce the amount of water used on a daily basis. This could include reduced watering of lawns, proper selection of drought tolerant landscape materials, never watering the lawn in the heat of the day, collection of rainwater for landscaping needs, and many other measures that can help.
