

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2007 – 24
22ND JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
McHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Circuit Court of McHenry County, Illinois, was established as the 22ND Judicial Circuit, a single-county judicial circuit on December 4, 2006, and that at that time the Circuit Court of McHenry County, Illinois, ceased to be a part of the 19TH Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, the Circuit Court of McHenry County, Illinois, as part of the 19TH Judicial Circuit, had entered into a contract through the Chief Judge of the 19TH Judicial Circuit with McHenry County College whereby McHenry County College would operate a Traffic Safety School Program in accordance with the requirements of the Illinois Supreme Court Rule 529(c) and the standards for traffic safety schools set by the Conference of Chief Circuit Judges; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed appropriate because of the realignment of the Circuit Court of McHenry County, Illinois, from the 19TH Judicial Circuit to the 22ND Judicial Circuit that a new contract be entered into between the 22ND Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, and McHenry County College so that the Traffic Safety School Program may continue to operate in McHenry County;

THEREFORE, THE COURT ORDERS:


1. That the 22ND Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, is authorized to enter into a Contract with McHenry County College whereby the National Safety Council's Traffic Safety School Programs specified in the Contract will be conducted by McHenry County College.
2. That for traffic tickets written in the 22ND Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, and not requiring a court appearance (as set out in Illinois Supreme Court Rule 551), the Court is authorized to enter an Order of Supervision under 730 ILCS 5/5-6-3.1, upon a written plea of guilty, provided that the motorists:

- a) had not within the twelve (12) preceding months been placed on Supervision or attended a Court ordered Traffic Safety School; and
- b) pays the fines and costs required by law and a tuition fee in the amount specified in the Contract for the specific traffic safety school course attended; and
- c) successfully completes the assigned Traffic Safety School program within the time set by the Court.

THIS ORDER is effective upon the signing of a Contract between the 22ND Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, and McHenry County College as described above and, further, that 19TH Judicial Circuit Administrative Order No. 98-16, entered on September 16, 1998, shall be vacated immediately at the time that this Administrative Order becomes effective.
