

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2008 – 11
22nd JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
McHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

GRAND JURY

THE COURT having considered the MOTION TO AMEND GRAND JURY TERM AND SCHEDULE filed by Louis A. Bianchi, State's Attorney for McHenry County, Illinois, on September 26, 2008, and pursuant to the applicable statutes of the State of Illinois and the Rules of Practice of the Circuit Court of the 22nd Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, and the Court being fully advised in the premises,

THIS COURT FINDS: That it is necessary that the Grand Jury be convened in McHenry County, Illinois on the schedule set forth below;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, as follows:

1. That the Grand Jury shall be impaneled twelve times per year.
2. The term of the Grand Jury shall be for one calendar month.
3. During its term, the Grand Jury shall be in session on every Wednesday and Thursday of the month on days on which the Circuit Court of the 22nd Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, is in session.
4. When in session, the regular hours of the Grand Jury shall be 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
5. That each Grand Jury chosen, impaneled and sworn, for each term of service shall serve until the next Grand Jury is so chosen, impaneled and sworn.
6. There will be no more than one Grand Jury in session at the same time.
7. That the Presiding Judge of the Criminal Division of this Circuit shall have the authority and discretion to make any modifications or adjustments to the schedule set forth in this Administrative Order.
8. This Administrative Order is effective on Thursday, January 8, 2009, and 22nd Judicial Circuit Administrative Order No. 2007-10 is vacated as of Thursday, January 8, 2009.
