AOIC Child Protection Data Courts Project

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court of the 22ND Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, has been selected by the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts (AOIC), working in conjunction with the National Center for State Courts (NCSC), to participate in data collection to measure child protection court performance measures.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the project is to enable the Court to improve efficiency and effectiveness in child protection cases, it is necessary for AOIC and NCSC to have on-site visits at the McHenry County Government Center, which includes access to and review of the Juvenile Court files and in-court observation of Juvenile Proceedings.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that representatives of AOIC and NCSC, as approved and designated by AOIC, shall have access to the Juvenile Court files both electronically and hard copy and shall be allowed to review said files. Copies of documents from the Juvenile Court files shall not be made without the specific written approval of the Court. Any identifying information of the juveniles involved in the cases accessed and/or reviewed shall remain confidential and not be disclosed by the persons accessing and reviewing the files.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that representatives of AOIC and NCSC, as approved and designated by AOIC, shall be allowed in the Juvenile Courtroom to observe the proceedings therein. Any identifying information of juveniles involved in the cases observed by said representatives shall remain confidential and not be disclosed.
