You Can Make a Difference!

Suicide is a public health issue. Over 40,000 people in the United States die from suicide annually, or 1 person every 13 minutes. More people die by suicide than from automobile accidents. Take the QPR (Question, Persuade, Refer) Suicide Prevention Course. In as little as 1½ hours, individuals can learn to recognize the warning signs of suicide and how to apply three simple steps that may save a life.

Each attendee will receive a QPR booklet and card with information on suicide prevention, as well as resource information for treatment and supports within their community.
