

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2011-06
22nd JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
McHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

IT IS ORDERED that all prior Administrative Orders establishing judicial assignments and court calls are hereby vacated and that this Administrative Order is effective on April 25, 2011.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following judicial assignments and court calls are established.

CRIMINAL DIVISION

Judge Sharon L. Prather – Presiding Judge of the Criminal Division

CRIMINAL FELONY I CALL (Judge Sharon L. Prather – Courtroom 304)

½ of Criminal Felony (CF) and Miscellaneous Remedy (Search Warrants, Rendition, Habeas Corpus (criminal), Eavesdropping, Fugitives from Justice, Forfeitures, and Sexually Violent Person Commitment Act proceedings) (MR).

CRIMINAL FELONY II CALL (Judge Joseph P. Condon – Courtroom 302)

½ of Criminal Felony (CF) and Miscellaneous Remedy (Search Warrants, Rendition, Habeas Corpus (criminal), Eavesdropping, Fugitives from Justice, Forfeitures, and Sexually Violent Person Commitment Act proceedings).

CRIMINAL MISDEMEANOR JURY CALL (Judge Charles P. Weech – Courtroom 301)

Criminal Misdemeanors (CM); Driving under the influence (DT); Traffic Violation (TR); Conservation Violation (CV); Ordinance Violation (OV); Extradition (MR); Mental Health Court; excluding all jury demand cases from Courtroom 101.

CRIMINAL MISDEMEANOR JURY CALL (Judge Gordon E. Graham – Courtroom 303)

Criminal Misdemeanors (CM); Driving under the influence (DT); Traffic Violation (TR); Conservation Violation (CV); Ordinance Violation (OV); excluding all jury demand cases from Courtroom 102.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CASES

Criminal Misdemeanor (CM) involving all domestic violence matters; Domestic Battery; Violations of Orders of Protection; Related Orders of Protection; Interference with reporting Domestic Violence.

MISDEMEANOR NON-JURY CALL (Judge Robert K. Baderstadt – Courtroom 101)

Criminal Misdemeanor (CM); Driving Under the Influence (DT); Traffic Violation (TR); Conservation Violation (CV); Miscellaneous Remedy (Forfeitures arising out of CM or DT cases)(MR); excluding all cases assigned to Courtroom 102.

MISDEMEANOR NON-JURY CALL (Judge Robert A. Wilbrandt, Jr. – Courtroom 102)

All Bench Trials, Summary Suspension Hearings, Judicial Driving Permit Proceedings, Forfeitures arising out of CM or DT cases assigned to this courtroom, excluding all cases assigned to Courtroom 101, Petitions to Revoke Proceedings and Bond Hearings in cases initiated by the following municipalities and/or state or local law enforcement agencies:

MUNICIPALITIES

City of McHenry

Village of Lakemoor

Village of Bull Valley

McHenry County Conservation District

Illinois Department of Natural Resources Conservation Police

Illinois State Police

McHenry County Sheriff- Only misdemeanor charges written on uniform traffic citations, such as DUI, DLR, No valid DL, Reckless Driving, etc.

TRAFFIC CALL (Judge Mark R. Gerhardt – Courtroom 103)

Traffic Violation (TR); Conservation Violation (CV); Ordinance Violation (OV); excluding Lake In The Hills and Sheriff traffic cases which are assigned to Courtroom 102.

SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT (Criminal/Civil/Family) (Judge Michael W. Feetterer - Courtroom 203)

Assignment to trials, hearings and other proceedings through case management procedures; vacation and school coverage for Misdemeanor Non-Jury Call, Criminal Misdemeanor Jury Call, Traffic Call and Juvenile Court Call (Detention hearings, Sheltered Care hearings and other emergency matters).

WEEKDAY FIRST APPEARANCE AND BOND COURT (Rights Courtroom in McHenry County Adult Corrections Facility)

Judge presiding in Criminal Misdemeanor Courtroom 301.

WEEKEND (SATURDAY) AND COURT HOLIDAY FIRST APPEARANCE AND BOND COURT (Rights Courtroom in McHenry County Adult Corrections Facility)

Judges assigned on a rotating schedule kept by Court Administration.

WEEKLY DUTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENT

Outside regular Court hours, the Duty Judge has primary responsibility for handling Emergency Matters, i.e., Search Warrants, Arrest Warrants, Orders of Protection and other Emergency Matters. During regular Court hours, the Duty Judge has primary responsibility to respond to requests for assistance by the Court Administration Office.

Judges assigned on a rotating schedule kept by Court Administration.

CIVIL DIVISION

Judge Michael T. Caldwell – Presiding Judge of the Civil Division

CIVIL I COURT CALL (Judge Michael T. Caldwell – Courtroom 204)

One-half of all Eminent Domain (ED); one-half of all Law (claims over \$50,000.00) (LA); one-half of all Miscellaneous Remedy (MR) (except for MR matters assigned to the criminal courts as in this Administrative Order); one-half of Chancery (CH) including one-half of all contested Mortgage Foreclosure cases as assigned, but excluding all uncontested and default Mortgage Foreclosure cases; and one-half of all Arbitration Award Rejections of AR and SC cases with jury demands.

CIVIL II COURT CALL (Judge Thomas A. Meyer – Courtroom 201)

One-half of all Eminent Domain (ED); one-half of all Law (claims over \$50,000.00) (LA); one-half of all Miscellaneous Remedy (MR) (except for MR matters assigned to the criminal courts as stated in this Administrative Order); one-half of Chancery (CH) including one-half of all contested Mortgage Foreclosure cases as assigned, but excluding all uncontested and default Mortgage Foreclosure cases; one-half of all Arbitration Award Rejections of AR and SC cases with jury demands.

CIVIL III COURT CALL (Judge James S. Cowlin – Courtroom 358)

Chancery (CH) (all uncontested and default Mortgage Foreclosure cases, but excluding contested Mortgage Foreclosure cases); all Law (claims under \$50,000.00) (LM); and all non-support matters only (FA and CM cases for collection of child support only) (Note: The non-support cases were formerly assigned to Courtroom 359 under Administrative Order 2008-1).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for purposes of this Order, the term “contested mortgage foreclosure case” shall be defined to include (1) any mortgage foreclosure case in which there has been filed, by any party, an affirmative defense, a counter-claim/cross-claim or third party claim; (2) any mortgage foreclosure case in which a motion for summary judgment has been denied on a substantive, not procedural basis; (3) any mortgage foreclosure case in which a mechanic’s lien claim has been filed within the mortgage foreclosure case or separately concerning the subject real property; and (4) any other basis as determined by the judge hearing the uncontested and default mortgage foreclosure call.

CIVIL IV COURT CALL (Judge John D. Bolger – Courtroom 357)

Arbitration (Bench) (Mandatory Arbitration) (AR); Mandatory Arbitration Supervisor; Small Claims (Bench) (SC); Small Claims Mediation Supervisor.

CIVIL V COURT CALL (Judge Michael J. Sullivan – Courtroom 365)

Probate (PR); Municipal Corporations (MC); Mental Health (MH); Tax (TX).

FAMILY DIVISION

Judge Michael J. Chmiel – Presiding Judge of the Family Division

FAMILY I CALL (Judge Gerald Martin Zopp, Jr. – Courtroom 361)

1/3 of Dissolution or Divorce (DV) and Family (FA) (excluding cases relating only to non-support matters).

FAMILY II CALL (Judge Suzanne C. Mangiamele – Courtroom 360)

1/3 of Dissolution or Divorce (DV) and Family (FA) (excluding cases relating only to non-support matters); Independent Orders of Protection (OP).

FAMILY III CALL (Judge Michael J. Chmiel – Courtroom 359)

1/3 of Dissolution or Divorce (DV) and Family (FA) (excluding cases relating only to non-support matters).

JUVENILE COURT CALL (Judge Maureen P. McIntyre – Courtroom 202)

Juvenile Abuse and Neglect (JA); Juvenile Delinquent (JD); Juvenile (JV); Adoption (AD).

CHIEF JUDGE'S ADMINISTRATIVE CALL: (Judge Michael J. Sullivan – Chief Judge of the 22nd Judicial Circuit – Courtroom 365)

All motions and other matters brought to the attention of the Chief Judge; in the absence of the Chief Judge, Judge Sharon L. Prather is Acting Chief Judge (Courtroom 304).
