FILING OF ORDERS FOR PEN REGISTERS

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That every Application for Pen Register, brought pursuant to 18 USC 2703, 3122, 3123 or 3124, wherein the Application sets forth reasonable grounds to believe that the contents of a wire or electronic communication, or the records or other information sought are relevant and material to an ongoing criminal investigation, shall be presented to the issuing Judge in duplicate. The police officer presenting such Application shall affirm or be sworn under oath.


That the police officer shall retain one copy of the executed Application and one copy of the Order entered, and the issuing Judge shall retain the other copy of the executed Application and Order entered, which the issuing Judge shall file with the McHenry County Circuit Clerk on the next business day.

That the McHenry County Circuit Clerk shall file all such Applications and Orders for Pen Register as separate Miscellaneous Remedy (MR) cases, indicating the date of the Application and Order and the Judge who signed the Order.

That as Applications and Orders pertain to ongoing criminal investigations, the McHenry County Circuit Clerk shall impound said files and all Applications and Orders for Pen Register, pending further Order of Court.
