



## **Grant/Purchase of Position/ Fee-for-Service Funding Agreement Outcomes**

The McHenry County Mental Health Board (MCMHB) has adopted a revised version of the SAMHSA National Outcome Measures (NOMs) Framework to promote the use of consistent measures across its programs. According to the Illinois Department of Human Services' Department of Mental Health, Outpatient Services are provided in partnership with community-based agencies and mental health care centers. These services are designed to help people live independently as they stabilize and move toward recovery. Outpatient services include core mental health services such as counseling, individual and group therapy, medication, and medication monitoring. They also include support in getting and holding a job, finding a place to live, staying in school, improving social relationships, and gaining access to benefit programs. The MCMHB Outcomes are comprised of 10 domains that embody meaningful, real life outcomes for people who are striving to attain and sustain recovery; build resilience; and work, learn, live, and participate fully in their communities. Each Provider shall chose 2 Outcomes (Domain 1 – 7) to report on during the contract period. Domains 8 – 10 are required of all Providers.

### **Domain 1 – Increased Knowledge/Resiliency**

Providers will report their efforts on a quarterly basis through the Grant Lifecycle Manager (GLM) System. Through the Outcomes Domain Reporting System, the MCMHB and its partners will:

- Standardize operational definitions and outcome measures
- Develop benchmarking strategies to determine acceptable levels of outcomes
- Produce routine management reports to direct MCMHB's evaluation of services
- Support interventions designed to result in improved outcomes
