ORDER MAKING CHANGES IN JUDICIAL ASSIGNMENTS

IT IS ORDERED that on Monday, June 3, 2019, the following changes in judicial assignments shall be effective:

CRIMINAL DIVISION

CRIMINAL FELONY I CALL (Judge Michael E. Coppedge – Courtroom 304)

One-half (1/2) of Criminal Felony (CF) and Miscellaneous Remedy (MR) (Search Warrants, Rendition, Habeas Corpus (criminal), Eavesdropping, Fugitives from Justice, Forfeitures, and Sexually Violent Person Commitment Act proceedings), Expungement and Sealing of Criminal Records.

SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT (CRIMINAL/CIVIL) (Judge Sharon L. Prather – Courtroom 357)

Assignment to trials, hearing, and other proceedings through case management procedures; vacation, and school coverage for Misdemeanor Non-Jury Call, Criminal Misdemeanor Jury Call, and Traffic Call. Back-up Courtroom 104 Summary Suspension Hearings.

During regular Court hours, the Special Assignment Judge (Criminal/Civil) shall have primary responsibility to respond to requests for assistance by the Court Administration Office, when not actively covering a courtroom. If both the Special Assignment Judge (Criminal/Civil) and the Duty Judge are in Court or otherwise unavailable, then it is the responsibility of the other Judges in the Duty Judge Rotation Schedule to respond to requests for assistance from the Court Administration Office. For the purposes of this Administrative Order, regular Court hours are defined as: between 8:30 a.m.- 12:00 p.m., and between 1:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. each day Court is in session.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on Monday, June 3, 2019, the following changes in judicial assignments shall be effective:

FAMILY DIVISION


FAMILY II CALL (Judge Jeffrey L. Hirsch – Courtroom 360)

One-third (1/3) of Dissolution or Divorce (DV), and Family (FA) (excluding cases relating only to non-support matters initiated by the Office of the Illinois Attorney General).

Divorce (DV) cases assigned to Judge Hirsch will be proved-up in CR365.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Administrative Order 2019-03 shall remain in full force and effect in all aspects other than the specific judicial assignment changes established by this Administrative Order.
