



Criminal & Traffic Assessment Act

YOUR OPTIONS AFTER RECEIVING A TRAFFIC TICKET:

- 1 If your ticket is marked "No Court Appearance Required" you have the option to pay this ticket BEFORE the court date listed at the bottom of the ticket without appearing in court. You must enter a plea even if bond was posted on the ticket. See Option B inside this brochure.
- 2 If your ticket is marked "No Court Appearance Required" you may pay the ticket and request Court Supervision with Traffic School BEFORE your court date. If you complete Traffic School and get no other tickets during the 120 day Court Supervision, this ticket will not be reported as a conviction to the Secretary of State. See Option C inside.
- 3 You can PLEAD NOT GUILTY and request a trial. Mail your Not Guilty Plea to the Circuit Clerk BEFORE the court date listed at the bottom of your ticket to avoid multiple court appearances. See Option A inside this brochure.
- 4 You can appear in court on the court date listed at the bottom of your ticket. If your ticket is marked "Court Appearance Required" you must either appear or plead not guilty and request a trial.

Please allow 7-10 days after receiving your ticket for the information to be available online for payment. If coming to the Courthouse to make payment or show proof of insurance, check online at www.McHenryCircuitClerk.org with a Case Information Search to make sure your ticket appears in the Clerk's database BEFORE driving to Woodstock.

If you posted a cash bond, deduct it from your amount paid.

- Pay \$164—Plead Guilty—All Minor Traffic Violations

AMOUNT TO PAY If you posted a cash bond, deduct it from your amount paid. Amounts listed below include the cost of your ticket, PLUS the Traffic School fee.

- Pay \$207—Plead Guilty—All Minor Traffic Violations

Payment Amounts

Fines, Penalties, Assessments, and Costs

The amount of payment for offenses where court appearances are not required is:

- (a) \$164.00 for any violation under the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/1 et seq.) defined as a minor traffic offense pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 501(f), except (b) below;
- (b) \$260.00 plus the minimum fine set by statute for truck overweight and permit violations under 3-401(d), 15-111, 15-113.1, 15-113.2 or 15-113.3 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/3-401(d), 15-111, 15-113.1, 15-113.2 or 15-113.3);
- (c) \$195.00 for any violation defined as a Conservation Offense under Supreme Court Rule 501(c) for which civil penalties are not required.

NOTE: Payment must be by cash, money order, certified check, bank draft, or traveler's check unless otherwise authorized by the clerk of the court. (DO NOT SEND CASH IN THE MAIL; use cash only if paying in person.)

- All Payable Minor Traffic – Schedule 12 - \$164
- Overweight – Schedule 10.5 - \$260 + minimum fine
- Conservation – Schedule 11 - \$195

- Civil Law Violations – no change (still \$120)





Criminal Waivers

- *Criminal & Traffic Assessment Act* creates new Criminal Waiver process, similar to the current process for waiving Civil fees
- Schedule Assessments are eligible to be waived for who qualify (up to 400% FPL)
- Criminal Waivers are NOT eligible for VEHICLE CODE violations

- Public Act 100-0697 created Firearms Restraining Orders effective 1-1-2019





VP2 Update

- Ticket format changes will be ready for July 1st
- Process for July 1st upgrade
- Multiple “May Appear” tickets do NOT require court appearance – Supreme Court Rule 503 revision (effective 7-1-2018)
- Cannabis “CL” Statutes available in VP2
- Overweight Forms

Avoid Filing Duplicates

- When transporting to Jail, change status to 'Removed' in VP2 to avoid filing duplicates
 - Log into **IUCS**
 - Click on **Leader / Leader Application**
 - Click on **Stop List**
 - Put in date range and/or other criteria
 - Click '**Search**'
 - Change Status to '**REMOVED**' on defendants brought to Jail
