Whereas upon the creation of the 22nd Judicial Circuit of McHenry County, Illinois, in the year 2006, Administrative Order 2006-12 was entered adopting prior Administrative Orders entered by the Chief Judge of the 19th Judicial Circuit, Lake and McHenry County, Illinois, which were in effect and pertained to McHenry County, Illinois; and

Whereas, there was in effect a certain Administrative Order requiring the Probation/Court Services Department to report foreign born adult probationers to the United States Department of Justice-Immigration and Naturalization Services for whom a pre-sentence investigation has been ordered or who are sentenced to a period of probation or conditional discharge; and


Whereas, the matter of such reporting by Probation/Court Services Departments across the State is currently under review by the Conference of Chief Judges of the State of Illinois. Until such review and action, if any, is completed, and until such time as further guidance is given, if any, the undersigned deems it prudent to vacate any prior Administrative Order requiring or authorizing reporting to the Immigration and Naturalization Service or any agency created in its stead.

Therefore, It Is Hereby Ordered that any prior Administrative Order requiring or authorizing reporting of foreign born adult probationers to the

Department of Justice-Immigration and Naturalization Services or any department acting in its stead is vacated.

It Is Further Ordered that any requests by the current Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agency or similar agency will be referred to the Office of Chief Judge of the 22nd Judicial Circuit for review and consult.
